### Cancellation of Placement Test for other language courses other than JASP3340

Placement test for other language courses in 2020-21 Term 2 will be cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Only students who have passed the required level of Japanese Language Proficiency test (JLPT) /can provide documentary proof of their Japanese language ability (e.g. official transcripts/ Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination Certificate) will be exempted for a particular language course. ## General notes for students taking Japanese language courses

### JASP1450/1460/2450/2460 (New Practical Japanese I/II/III/IV)

- Due to fast progress of the course, students are strongly advised to complete the add/drop as soon as possible during the add/drop period.
- Students must obtain Grade C- or above to be qualified to take the succeeding level courses. Students will be asked to drop the succeeding course should they fail to meet this requirement, even though they have successfully registered in the succeeding course through CUSIS.
- Students who do not attend class without medical certificate or strong reasons will result in mark deduction. Students who do not attend one-third of classes may fail the subject. For details, please refer to the regulations distributed in the first lesson.
- In view of the spread of COVID-19, postgraduate students who are interested in taking the language courses are NOT require to come to the General Office counter in person for registration. Instead, they are required to send a written request with the **completed CS-1 form** (<https://www.gs.cuhk.edu.hk/download/CS1.pdf>) along with both the student's and supervisor's signatures, course code, course title, class session and personal information to [japanese-studies@cuhk.edu.hk](mailto:japanese-studies@cuhk.edu.hk) to do the registration in advance. Registrations are on a *first-come, first-served*

*basis*. Colleagues will contact you whether your course registration will be approved or not. For Term 2 language courses, registration starts *from now till 23 January 2021*.

### Students who have passed the placement test for language course

Students who have passed the placement test and/or are exempted for a particular language course due to prior knowledge of Japanese are only allowed to take language courses at level higher than the exempted course.

### ADD/DROP Arrangement

Please note that NOT all add/drop could be done in the CUSIS system. You must check information on CUSIS whether you are required to send a written request to the Department to add/drop a particular course.

### Declaration of Minor in Japanese Studies Programmes

For students who are interested in declaring minor in Japanese Studies Programmes, please submit your application in CUSIS during the application period announced by Registration & Examinations Office.
