- THEO and CURE courses at 2000 and above level shall be included in the calculation of the major Grade Point Average (GPA) for honours classification.

Minor Programme in Theology

Undergraduate students from different disciplines may pursue a minor programme in Theology in addition to their major degree programmes. Students minor in Theology are required to complete a minimum of 18 units of THEO courses, with at least one course at 2000 or above level and another two courses at 3000 or above level.

Remarks:

- ^ Students are allowed to take these courses more than once, and gain the units each time they pass the course. However, students cannot take courses with the same course code more than once in a single term.
1. A course code comprises four alphabets and four numerals. The first four alphabets denote the subjects and the course offering units. For instance, “**THEO**” indicates theology courses offered by Divinity School of Chung Chi College; while “**PHIL**” indicates philosophy courses offered by the Department of Philosophy. Students should consult the course offering units concerned for enquiries related to course registration and selection.
 2. In the University, each unit of course should be regarded as equivalent to one contact hour per week for 13 –14 weeks in an academic term. Most three-unit courses are composed of three hours of lectures, or two hours of lecture and one hour of tutorial, per week.
 3. Courses listed above will be offered according to resources available in each term and year. Details of course offerings in a particular term will be announced at course registration time.
