Grades for Students Who Withdraw or Take Leave Near End of Term

- 1. Normally, the Graduate School will not record any grade for that term for any student who withdraws or takes leave before the last day of the term.
- 2. If special circumstances warrant, the teacher concerned may assign a grade for a postgraduate course to a postgraduate student who withdraws or takes leave near the end of the term, but an explanatory note must be sent to the Graduate School. For example, if the course requires a project and it has already been handed in, or if the course is a seminar and the student has already made his presentation, a grade (which may be a passing grade or a failure) may be given.
