

Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macau University Alliance

Greater Bay Area Summer School

To promote collaborations and provision of quality education in Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macau University Alliance (GHMUA), funding has been granted from UGC in the 2019-22 triennium to support credit-earning study programs.

Under this one-off funding scheme, a provision of around HK\$150,000 per year will be allocated to GHMUA Greater Bay Area Summer School. The School is established to provide up to three credit-bearing courses in Hong Kong to students from member institutions and from the Greater Bay Area. The students will learn about teaching and research strengths by participating in credit-bearing courses and enrichment activities.

All UGC-funded member universities of GHMUA are invited to offer course under the GHMUA Greater Bay Summer School. A subsidy of HK\$50,000 will be provided to each course to be run for a credit-bearing summer school exclusively to students from Greater Bay Area in July/August of the year. A minimum of two credits should be offered for each course. The courses funded by this scheme has to be named under “ GHMUA Greater Bay Area Summer School (粵港澳高校聯盟暑期學院)”. A report outlining the activities and the utilization of the funding is required within one month upon completion of the summer school.
