Part-time Lecturer, Department of Social Work, The Chinese University of Hong Kong

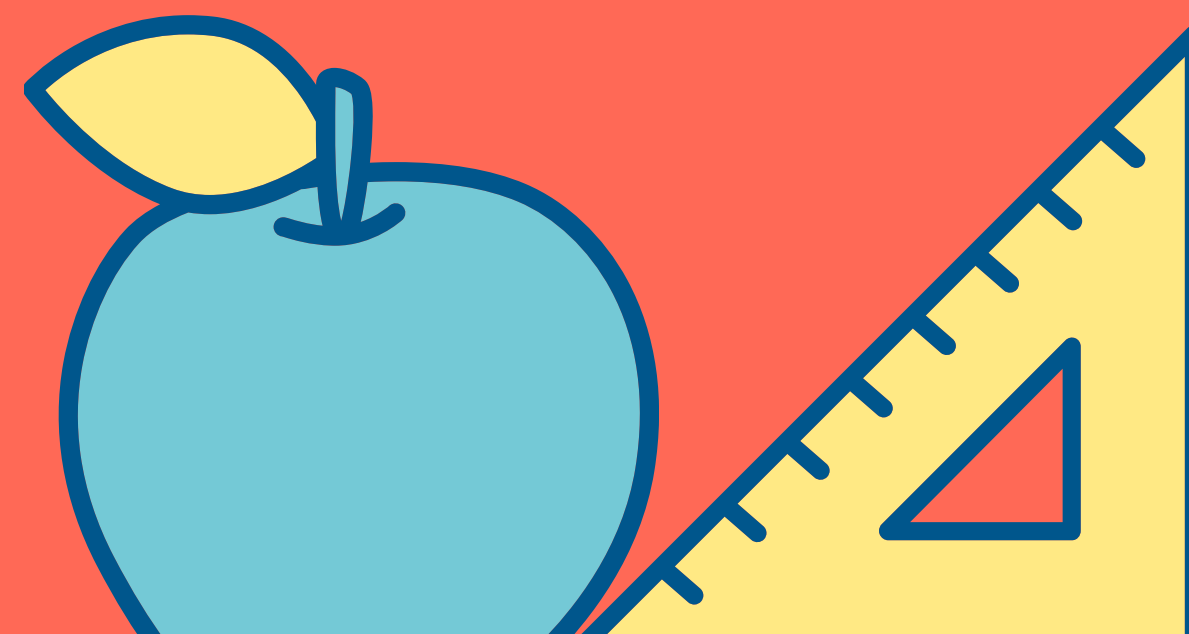
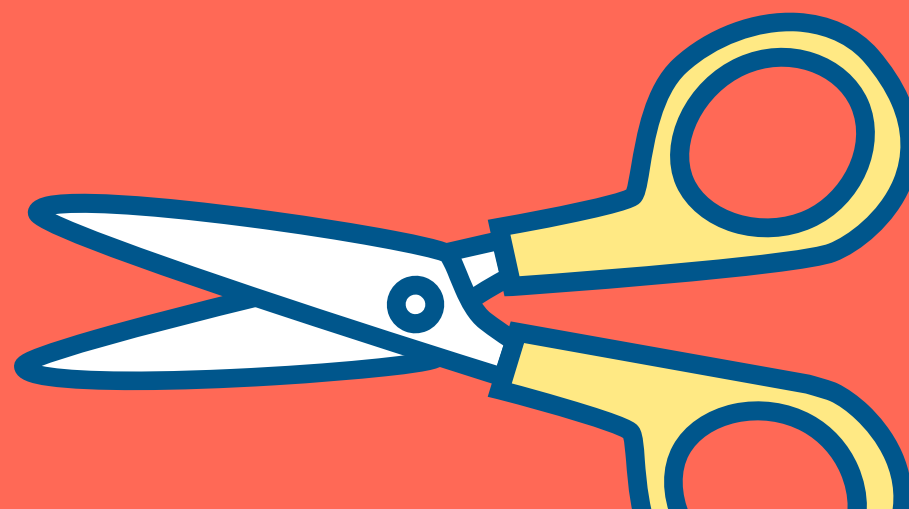
