	<b>6. Quality and quantity of visual aids (e.g., pictures, infographics)</b>	Plenty of visual aids are used. Most or all of them are directly relevant to the learning objective. 	<b>7. Visual elements (e.g. special effects, AR/VR, animations, editing effects)</b>	Suitable visual effects were used to enhance learning.	No or few visual effects were used.
