- submit a written report to the College within one month upon returning to Hong Kong. The College reserves the right to edit the report for publication purposes;
- assist the College in the promotion of cultural exchange activities (such as production of display boards, webpage and to share with other College students their experience abroad);
- Upon satisfactory completion of the above requirements, students will be eligible for consideration of the United College GOAL Scholarships supported by the College Endowment Fund according to the following rate:  
**Region 1 : Asia and Oceania – HK\$8,000 (1 course) or HK\$10,000 (2 courses)**  
**Region 2 : Europe and Americas – HK\$10,000 (1 course) or HK\$15,000 (2 courses)**

### Selection of the Scholarships will be based on:

- Applicant's Overall GPA;
- Applicant's participation in the extra curricular activities organised by the College;
- Priority will be given to those who have no previous overseas exchange experience.
