Kwai-Cheung Lo, Professor in the Department of Humanities and Creative Writing, and Director of Creative and Professional Writing Program at Hong Kong Baptist University, is the author of *Excess and Masculinity in Asian Cultural Productions* (State University of New York Press, 2010), and *Chinese Face / Off: The Transnational Popular Culture of Hong Kong* (University of Illinois Press, 2005), and the editor of a Chinese-language anthology entitled *Re-Sighting Asia: Deconstruction and Reinvention in the Global Era* (Chinese University Press, 2014).
