





A specialist training on career facilitation and development services

Through the School of Continuing and Professional Studies of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUSCS), over 700 professionals credentialed as **Global Career Development Facilitators** (**GCDFs**) have been serving the community since 2014. This mission is continuing through the **Facilitating Career Development (FCD) Programme**, which further expands the focus of training beyond facilitation to equip practitioners with the resources to become effective career services providers or career development specialists.

Trainees are eligible to apply for two globally recognised credentials on completion of the FCD Programme: Certified Career Services Provider 職涯服務規劃師 (CCSP), and Global Career Development Facilitator全球職涯發展師 (GCDF).



Who Needs the Training

- Anyone in a position or with an interest in providing career facilitation and development services in settings or areas of work that involve:
 - individual or group career facilitation and development
 - career resource planning and coordination
 - job search or placement
 - workforce development or human resource management
 - employability skills and training
 - social and business / consulting services
- Though with a mind to come and get trained to help others, people completing career development training often find it is THEY themselves who are helped most.

Programme Structure

The Facilitating Career Development (FCD) Programme equips trainees with the relevant skills and knowledge to design, deliver, and manage career services for assisting others in planning careers, getting empowered, and finding value and meaning in work at different points of their career path.

FCD Instructors & Master Trainers at CUSCS

- All instructors are certified by NCDA to teach the Facilitating Career Development (FCD) curriculum. They are
 experienced CUSCS trainers coming from a diversity of career background. Many have received professional
 counseling or human resources management training, or have attained certifications for various career
 development or personality assessment tools.
- Master Trainers are certified by NCDA (USA) to provide FCD Instructor training globally.

One Programme, Two Certifications

On completion of the FCD Programme, trainees are eligible to apply for two globally recognised certifications:



Certified Career Services Provider 職涯服務規劃師 (CCSP) National Career Development Association (NCDA), USA

CCSPs provide services in various scales and depths to address common needs and issues in career development, facilitation, and planning.



Global Career Development Facilitator 全球職涯發展師 (GCDF)

Center for Credentialing and Education (CCE) of National Board for Certified Counsellors (NBCC), USA

GCDFs help people meet their career goals by providing facilitation and guidance, empowering them to explore, reflect, and make informed decisions when considering career options.

Continuing Development

A Certified Career Services Provider (CCSP) is required to obtain 30 hours of continuing education (i.e. 30 CEUs) during each 3-year period of validity for the credential.

All Continuing Education Units (CEUs) must relate to one of the 12 core competencies and can be obtained from a variety of ways such as enrolling in college/university courses, attending or presenting at seminars, workshops, conferences and webinars, designing and delivering career development training/courses, and writing articles for publications or conducting research.



- Established in 1913, NCDA is the first, longest running and preeminent career development association in the world.
- NCDA was an early partner with the National Occupational Information Coordinating Committee (NOICC) and the Center for Credentialing and Education (CCE) in developing and implementing the Career Development Facilitator concept, as well as designing a specific curriculum to train such facilitators. NCDA is also a founding division of the American Counseling Association (ACA).
- Over the years, NCDA has prepared over 25,000 Career Services Providers and Facilitators for inter/national certification.



- Authorised by the Center for Credentialing and Education of the National Board for Certified Counselors (NBCC), USA, CUSCS introduced the Global Career Development Facilitator Programme (GCDF) to Hong Kong in 2015.
- The GCDF certification was initially established in the States and is now offered in 23 countries and regions worldwide.
- More than 1,000 trainees have completed the GCDF training and over 700 have received the GCDF credential in Hong Kong.
