Coursework Requirement:

Students are required to complete a minimum of 24 credit units (**one core course** and any **seven elective courses** from the four Areas prescribed in the course list with at least TWO Areas chosen from Area 1, 2 and 3) for graduation.

- Core course RELS5005 Theories of Religious Studies
- Area 1 (Religion, Heritage and Context)
- Area 2 (Religion, Society and Culture)
- Area 3 (Religion, Life and Wisdom)
- Area 4 (Special Topics in Religious)

• Other Requirements:

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Students must take at least one course per term throughout the normative study period stipulated in the "General Regulations Governing Postgraduate Studies".
- Students must fulfill the Term Assessment Requirement of the Graduate School.
