## **Midterm Check Specification**

Midterm check aims to trace your project progress and help you to resolve your problems in your project. In addition, it gives you chances to practice your communication skills.

The guideline for the midterm check is as follows:

- 1. Each group is given five minutes to present your project.
- 2. No grade for your presentation, only some feedback.
- 3. You are allowed to use any form, e.g., word, PPT, etc. If you use PPT, please do not exceed 5 pages.

Your presentation should contain three aspects:

- 1. The impact of your project. For instance, you show why you choose this topic, and the potential of the project.
- 2. The progress of your project. For instance, you give how much you have finished according to your timeline in your proposal.
- 3. Q&A. For instance, you show the difficulties you face and possible solutions. You may get feedback from the tutor and other students.
