#### 1. Services Rendered

#### 1.1 Publications

# 1.1.1 Annual Report 2011–12

At the request of the University Secretary, publication of the *Annual Report* was aligned with the Council meeting in January where the *Report* would be received by the Council Members. ISO also assisted in the preparation of the yearly review materials by VC to Council Members at the said meeting.

# 1.1.2 Five Focused Areas of Research Brochures

In view of the overhauling of the focused schemes, the production of the brochures had been put on hold until further notice.

## 1.1.3 Sustainable Campus

In view of the greater emphasis on sustainability as a major University initiative and to save paper, it was decided that *Sustainable Campus* be revamped to electronic newsletter format from the 2013–14 season.

#### 1.1.4 Survive & Thrive in CUHK

To consolidate and provide essential campus information to the double cohort of students and new staff upon the reversion to the four-year normative curriculum, ISO produced a booklet *Survive & Thrive in CUHK* in August 2012.

#### 1.1.5 Others

A symposium on 'Language, Style and Publication in a University Context' was held on 26 November 2012 in collaboration with CUP and PO. The fill-day event was attended by over 200 colleagues from various departments/units/ offices and consisted of the following:

- Workflow in the publication process
- Chinese and English house-styles
- Translating a scholarly work into Chinese with due regard to the differences between national language and local usage
- Copyright and hyperlink issues in e-publications
- Developing a web style
- Speech-writing

Feedback from the participants was generally positive.

#### 1.2 Information Management

#### 1.2.1 Website management

ISO continued to manage the contents of the University homepage and provided sundries updating services.

#### 1.2.2 University homepage revamp

The University homepage revamp was completed and the new homepage launched in January 2013. A total of 14 web features were produced in the first six months of the revamp. A survey by questionnaire had been conducted to collect feedback for future enhancement purposes.

#### 1.2.3 Web Accessibility

The new University homepage had adopted the government's guidelines on web accessibility design, for which it was granted the Gold Award in the Web Accessibility Recognition Scheme jointly presented by the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer and the EOC.

#### 1.2.4 Webmaster community forum

With a view to promoting a common web culture across campus, the first webmaster community forum was held on 12 December 2012 in collaboration with ITSC. During this half-day forum, attended by about 160 webmasters or web administrators of various departments/units/offices, details of the Standards and Guidelines for all CUHK Websites were explained together with some suggestions for good practice in web design and administration.
