### Temporary Road Closure for New Student Orientation Day 2010

To facilitate the activities of the New Student Orientation Day 2010 on 30 July 2010 (Friday), the section of Central Avenue between Pi Ch'iu Building and University Library will be temporarily closed from 7:30 am to 6:30 pm to serve as a Designated Pedestrian Zone. Some of the shuttle bus routings and bus stops will be affected. Details are as follows:

<b>30 July 2010 (Friday) 7:30am - 6:30pm</b>	
Shuttle Bus (Up-route)	Fung King Hey Building bus stop to be suspended, change to Leung Kau Kui Building (Meet-Class) bus stop.
Shuttle Light Bus (Up-route)	University Library bus stop to be suspended, change to Sir Run Run Shaw Hall bus stop.
Circular Bus Route (7:45am-9:15am)	Y.C.Liang Hall bus stop to be suspended, change to car park space No.8 (opposite to Y.C.Liang Hall).

If Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above, or Rainstorm Black Warning Signal is still in force by 8:00 am on 30 July, the New Student Orientation Day will be postponed to 31 July and the above traffic arrangement is to be applied on 31 July. Any change of the traffic arrangement will depend on the weather condition and activity schedule of the event day.

### Inauguration Ceremony and Suspension of Classes on 6 September 2010

The first teaching day of 2010/11 will begin on 6 September 2010 with the Inauguration Ceremony for Undergraduates being held in that morning. As such, classes will be suspended (**except for MB ChB Programme Years 3-5**) from 8:30 am till 1:30 pm on 6 September 2010.
