Reminders for Non-local Students

Full-time undergraduate students who will continue to pursue studies at CUHK in the coming academic year 2015-16, please be reminded to ensure the validity of your travel documents, e.g. passport or Exit-entry Permit for Travelling to and from Hong Kong and Macao (「往來港澳通行證」), and the entry permit label.

If your current limit of stay will expire in August or September 2015, you are required to submit the completed "Extension of Stay" application form (ID 91) which is downloadable from the website of the Immigration Department via the following link and provide the documents required: <http://www.immd.gov.hk/eng/forms/forms/id91.html>. You are also required to submit a certifying letter which is to be issued by the Registration and Examinations Section: http://rgsntl.rgs.cuhk.edu.hk/rws_prd_life/re_menu/ap_0000005.asp.

In addition, an off-campus housing forum is open for students and staff to share accommodation information and experiences with each other.
