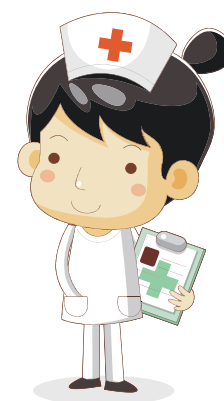
A Life-Saver: Mental Health First Aid (精神健康急救基礎課程)

With the belief that it is important to strengthen our resilience and equip ourselves to cope with life's challenges, a 12-hour Mental Health First Aid Standard Course will be organized in December 2011. The Course is especially offered to full-time postgraduate students.

The Course will enable participants to:

- Learn about the basic knowledge of depression, anxiety disorders, psychosis and substance abuse.
- Anticipate the possible crises which may arise from these mental health problems and proceed with the necessary intervention.
- Learn about community resources and help the person involved to seek professional treatment and make use of suitable resources.

Qualification acquired	: Participants who complete the 12-hour MHFAS Course will be awarded a “Mental Health First Aid Standard Course Certificate” issued by the Mental Health Association of Hong Kong and acknowledged by ORYGEN Research Center of the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Melbourne.
