The vetting of applications for UGC Block Grant Student Activities Fund (1st term, 2015-16), which aims to subsidize the registered undergraduate student societies in organizing co-curricular programmes, is expected to be completed in early October 2015. All successful applicants will receive the result and the amount granted from the Student Activities Section under separate cover by mid-October 2015.

Internationalization Activity Fund for Student Associations 2015-16

Purpose

The Internationalization Activity Fund aims to support student associations to organize activities which promote internationalization and intercultural exchange opportunities among members of the University community.

Eligibility

All registered undergraduate and postgraduate student associations are eligible for applying for financial support from the Fund.

Student bodies representing non-local ethnic or regional origins are encouraged to apply for the funding to organize activities for promoting campus integration and cohesion.

Assessment Criteria

- ☞ Consideration will be given to the overall merits of each application, including innovation and impact of the activity in enhancing the internationalization exposures of students outside the association concerned.
- ☞ Priority will be given to activities which involve a larger number of students, whether as participants or organizers.
- ☞ Inter-association collaboration will be highly encouraged.
- ☞ The Fund would not cover expenses of overseas exchange activities organized by student associations for their members.
- ☞ The maximum amount of support for each application is capped at \$10,000.

The United Nations Climate Change Convention (UNFCCC) Conference of Parties (COP) in Paris, will be held from 30 November 2015 (Monday) through 11 December 2015 (Friday). In this programme, the Hong Kong America Center will provide university students in Hong Kong and Macau the opportunity to learn by both listening and participating about this important meeting. A cast of officials and diplomats will brief students on this issue on 24 October 2015 (Saturday). There will be a keynote address by Hong Kong Under Secretary for the Environment, Christine Loh, and then a series of reports by diplomatic and other representatives of 9 key countries involved in the UN Climate Change Conference. On 14–15 November (Saturday–Sunday), there will be a policy simulation by student teams, while on 15 December (Tuesday), a live report from Paris to Hong Kong on the outcome of the Conference will be followed. The HKAC will enroll 54 students from universities in Hong Kong and Macau. Postgraduate and undergraduate students from all disciplines are welcome.
