Juddies 'uBuddies 2011' Peer Counselling Network

As part of the 'Keep Caring' Campaign, the Student Counselling and Development Service of the Office of Student Affairs is going to establish the 'uBuddies 2011' Peer Counselling Network to assist in promoting a caring and supportive campus culture in CUHK. Selected candidates will master effective peer counselling skills through a series of systematic training programmes. Upon completion of all training, the peer counsellors are expected to offer counselling and support to fellow students and, in the process, achieve their own personal growth.

Training:

- 4 sessions totalling 12 hours on peer counselling skills
- 3 days/2 nights adventure training camp to build team spirit; increase self-understanding and self-confidence
- 4 sessions totalling 12 hours on Mental Health First Aid Standard Course training
- Attainable Qualifications:
- GUHK uBuddies Certificate
- Certificate of Mental Health First Aid Standard Course (certificate is jointly issued by The Mental Health Association of Hong Kong and acknowledged by the ORYGEN Research Centre of the Department of Psychiatry, The University of Melbourne)
- Nomination for the Best uBuddies Awards
