Recruitment of senior leaders for O'camp for CUHK Postgraduates

The three-day Orientation Camp (O'camp) for CUHK Postgraduates (hosted by The Postgraduate Student Association of The Chinese University of Hong Kong, CUPSA) is designed to help new postgraduates to know more about CUHK, to get familiar with the new environment, to experience campus life and to make new friends. The O'camp, in the format of day camp, consists of various activities such as opening ceremony, welcome dinner, ice-breaking games, campus hunt, library visit, sharing session, and orientation talks. Students will be divided into groups. In each group, there are one or two senior leaders as well as 10–15 new postgraduates, who will spend the three days on campus together.

CUPSA is now recruiting senior leaders to guide and help the newcomers at the O'camp. This year, the first session is going to be held in early August while the second and third ones will be held in late August and early September. Those who are interested can choose one or more to take part in.

Requirements:

- 1. Alumni or current students with more than one-year learning experience at CUHK.
- 2. Senior leaders should be outgoing, friendly and have good organizing ability.
- 3. Senior leaders should be responsible and dedicated to completing the tasks of a whole session.



Students may check their UELA records and update their SELA** records in the SDP at www.cuhk.edu.hk/sdp with their Student ID and CWEM Password.

Applicants should provide all necessary information for verification and delivery arrangement. Successful applicants will receive an email confirmation in August 2015, followed by the delivery of the ELA Report by post. For non-graduate students:

For full-time undergraduate students who will continue to pursue studies at CUHK in the coming academic year 2015-16, please be reminded to ensure the validity of your travel documents, e.g. passport or Exit-entry Permit for Travelling to and from Hong Kong and Macao (往來港澳通行 讚), and the entry permit label.

If your current limit of stay will expire in June, July, August or September 2015, you are required to submit the completed "Extension of Stay" application form (ID 91) which is downloadable from the website of the Immigration Department via the following link and provide the documents required: www.immd.gov.hk/eng/forms/forms/id91.html. You are also required to submit a certifying letter which is to be issued by the Registration and Examinations Section: http://rgsntl.rgs.cuhk.edu.hk/rws_prd_life/re_menu/ap_00000005.asp.
