About the Programme

Since 1998, Dr. Lee Shiu and Dr. Jennie Mui Lee have initiated and sponsored various leadership programmes at several universities in Hong Kong, with the mission to nurture talents for the modernization of China. In the summer of 2014, a four-week programme organized by the University of Hong Kong, which crosses the borders of Hong Kong, Beijing and other Chinese cities will bring together 64 committed and outstanding students from Hong Kong, China and the USA, to undertake a collaborative study on the theme "In Preparation for 2047: Building a Creative Society of Integrity and Benevolence".

During the programme, the participants will study in groups in five important areas:

- Ethics and Integrity
- Civil Society
- Rule of Law
- Environment, Technology & Sustainable Development
- Social Mobility & Gap between Rich and Poor
