For non-graduating students:

For full-time undergraduate students who will continue to pursue studies at CUHK in the coming academic year 2014-15, please be reminded to ensure the validity of your travel documents, e.g. passport or Exit-entry Permit for Travelling to and from Hong Kong and Macao (往來港澳通行 證), and the entry permit label.

If your current limit of stay will expire in July, August or September 2014, you are required to submit the completed "Extension of Stay" application form (ID 91) which is downloadable from the website of the Immigration Department via the following link and provide the documents required: www.immd.gov.hk/ehtml/id91.htm. You are also required to submit a certifying letter which is to be issued by the Registration and Examinations Section: <u>http://rgsntl.rgs.cuhk.edu.hk/rws_prd_life/re_menu/ap_0000005.asp</u>.
