The role is challenging but the learning curve has been very steep.

### **My advice:**

### Reminder: You Are Reminded NOT To Involve in any unlicensed Guesthouse Operation

In view of a recent court case regarding the conviction of three Mainland post-graduate students for operating an unlicensed guesthouse, the Home Affairs Department would like to bring your attention to the followings:

Before commencing a hotel or guesthouse business in Hong Kong, a licence issued under the Hotel and Guesthouse Accommodation Ordinance shall be obtained. Under the Ordinance, "hotel/guesthouse" means any premises being held out by the occupier, proprietor or tenant for providing sleeping accommodation at a fee with a tenancy term of less than 28 continuous days.

Under section 5 of the Ordinance, any person operates, keeps, manages or otherwise has control of a guesthouse without a valid guesthouse licence commits an offence and will lead to a criminal record. Any person who is convicted for operating an unlicensed guesthouse is liable to imprisonment. The maximum penalty upon conviction is a \$200,000 fine and imprisonment for two years, and a fine of \$20,000 for each day during which the offence continues. According to records, heavier sentences for unlicensed guesthouse operations have been passed by the courts in the recent years. ### 溫馨提示: 切勿涉及任何經營無牌旅館事宜

鑑於新近有關三名內地碩士生因經營無牌旅館而被定罪一事，民政事務總署特別作出以下提醒：

凡在香港開展旅館業務，必須先領取根據《旅館業條例》發出的牌照。根據《條例》，“旅館”指任何處所，其佔用人、東主或租客顯示會提供收費的住宿地方，而出租期少於連續 28 天。

根據《條例》第 5 條，凡任何人沒有有效旅館牌照而經營、開設、管理或以其他方式控制旅館，即屬犯罪，並會留下刑事記錄。違者一經定罪，可被判監禁，最高可處罰款 20,000 元及監禁兩年，並可就罪行持續期間的每一天另處罰款 20,000 元。根據記錄，近年法院加重有關經營無牌旅館的刑罰，詳情請參閱牌照事務處網站 [www.hadla.gov.hk](http://www.hadla.gov.hk)。
