Qualifications for Admission

- Possess a Bachelor's degree from a recognized university
- Fulfill the “English Language Proficiency Requirement”
 - obtained a degree from a university in Hong Kong or taken a degree programme of which the medium of instruction was English; or
 - achieved scores in the following tests:
 - TOEFL (not lower than 550 paper-based/ 79 internet-based); or
 - IELTS (Academic) (not lower than Band 6.5); or
 - obtained a pass grade in English in one of the following examinations: (i) Hong Kong Advanced Level Examination (AS Level), (ii) Hong Kong Higher Level Examination, (iii) CUHK Matriculation Examination; or (iv) General Certificate of Education A-Level / AS-Level
 - achieved Level 4 or above in the English Language subject of the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Examination; or
 - obtained a recognized professional qualification, provided that the examination was conducted in English.

 - Official Transcripts and grading schemes of all tertiary level studies (i.e., in officially sealed envelopes)
 - Applicants who obtained degrees from universities in Mainland China are required to provide an Online Verification Report of Higher Education Qualification Certificate (教育部學歷證書電子註冊備案表) issued by the [CHESICC \(學信網\)](#).
 - 2 Letters of Recommendation (either via e-system or in hard copy)
 - Copies of Certificates of Graduation and HKID
 - **Original score report** of TOEFL or IELTS (if needed) (*Only results obtained within not more than two years from the test date are considered valid.*)
 - Assessment report from the HKCAAVQ (if necessary)

Selection & Result

- Selection
 - Selection Panel will begin the selection process after the application deadline
 - Neither entrance test nor interview is required
