The period under review in this report is from 1 August 2015 to 31 July 2016.

1. Services Rendered

1.1 Publications

In the year under review, the following institutional publications were produced according to published schedules and with enhancement in content, design and format whenever practicable:

- Annual Report
- Bulletin (2 issues)
- Calendar
- Contact Directory
- Facts & Figures
- Newsletter (20 issues) *
- CUHKUPDates (online editor's picks from Newsletter)
- Student Brochure
- Sustainable Campus (4 issues; e-version only)

Production details of the above publications are in the **Annex**.

*In collaboration with OIA and with a view to strengthening donor communication, a new feature in the Newsletter, 'Fine Folks Fine Deeds", was launched in October 2015 to good reception. Each instalment featured a donor or group of donors who had made contributions to the welfare of the University and/or its students. Six instalments had been published during the year under review.

ISO also helped to design and print the CUHK Strategic Plan 2016–2020.

1.2 Information Management

1.2.1 Website management

ISO continued to manage the contents of the University homepage including posting a total of 35 web articles featuring new University initiatives and significant achievements of CUHK members.

1.2.2 "Roll Call Alum"

In collaboration with AAO and with a view to strengthening alumni communication, a new monthly web feature 'Roll Call Alum' was launched in September 2015. Each instalment profiles an alumnus or alumna who's making his/her presence felt in different sectors. Eleven instalments had been published during the year under review. Its enthusiastic reception can be gauged by the hundreds of "likes" received by each instalment.

1.2.3 Website awards

The University homepage continued its grand slam of awards in the Web Accessibility Recognition Scheme jointly organized by the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer (OGCIO) and the Equal Opportunities Commission (EOC). In 2016, CUHK received a total of 16 awards including the "Triple Gold Award", "Most Favourite Website" and the "Easiest-to-Use Website" given to the CUHK homepage.

1.2.4 Enforcing minimum web standards

ISO completed the final phase of the enforcement exercise of the minimum web standards which started in July 2014. A total of 424 websites within the CUHK domain were targeted in this phase. 190 websites found to be obsolete or unused for a long time were removed. The remaining 234 websites had been brought to full compliance in July 2016.

1.2.5 CUHK in Pixels

A major initiative to provide open access to CUHK's rich visual resource, "CUHK in Pixels" was launched in November 2015. It now houses over

3,000 impressive photographs of the CUHK campus and its people, complete with a keyword search function which enables users to get hold of photographs with a variety of search criteria.
