C. Arrangements for Online Classes and Online Examinations

(a) Unless otherwise advised by the course teachers concerned with alternative arrangements, all

online classes and online examinations will continue as scheduled under any weather conditions,

including when Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above and/or Black Rainstorm Signal

is hoisted.

(b) For face-to-face meetings or face-to-face examinations that are specially approved to be

conducted on campus, please refer to "A. Suspension of Classes" and "B. Examinations

Arrangements" above for class/examination suspension. Course teachers concerned should arrange class make-up and postponement of examination when such class/examination

suspension happen due to weather conditions.

D. Campus Transport Arrangements

(a) If the local storm warning signal No. 8 or above is issued during class period, meet-class buses

will cease to operate whereas the normal shuttle bus service will be maintained for an hour. All

bus services will resume operation on a limited basis one hour after the said warning signal is

lowered (or the extreme condition notice, if any, is cancelled), unless the situation does not

permit.

- (b) If the black rainstorm warning signal is issued during class period, meet-class buses will cease to operate whereas the normal shuttle bus service will be maintained, unless the situation does not permit.
- (c) If the local storm warning signal No. 8 or above, the extreme condition notice or the black rainstorm warning signal is issued before the start of class period, all bus services will be suspended and will resume operation on a limited basis one hour after the said warning signal(s)/notice are cancelled, unless the situation does not permit.
