



簡介

中國語言及文學系為香港中文大學歷史最悠久之學系,具備國際學術地位。中國語言及文學學部為有志於中國語言及文學研究之學生,提供多元化之高級學位課程,包括哲學博士、哲學碩士及文學碩士課程。本系課程涵蓋範疇深廣並重,兼顧古典與現代學術傳統,為研究生提供語言文字、古代文獻、古典文學和現代文學四大領域之專業訓練。

本系學術氣氛濃厚,教師來自中國大陸、台灣、香港、日本、美國、加拿大、法國及蘇格蘭等地,具備國際視野。本系積極鼓勵研究生出席本地及海外之學術研討會,發表學術論文,參與各類型之學術活動,擴闊研究視野。

中國語言及文學學部之哲學博士課程以研究為主,博士研究生須在導師指導下從事專業課題研究,撰寫學位論文,並通過「博士資格考試」。博士研究生亦須於常規修業年內修讀講論會,並於專為研究生開設之課程中選修四至六門專業學科。本學部期待博士研究生畢業後能繼續從事大專教育及研究工作。

Introduction

The Department of Chinese Language and Literature, the oldest department of the Chinese University of Hong Kong, is highly regarded in the international academic community. The Division of Chinese Language and Literature under the Department offers diversified programmes leading to the MA, MPhil and PhD degrees to students who are determined to pursue academic advancement in the field of Chinese language and literature. The post-graduate programmes provide a wild range of courses, covering both the classical and modern areas. They enable students to cultivate their intellectual ability and develop research skills for four areas of specialization: Chinese linguistics and phonology, ancient Chinese texts, classical Chinese literature, and modern Chinese literature.

The Department, pervaded by a strong academic atmosphere, has drawn together professors from the Mainland China, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Japan, the United States, Canada, France and Scotland, and, as a result, is able to provide students with an international perspective for their research. The Department encourages our graduate students to present papers in both local and overseas conferences, to publish papers in academic journals and to participate in all other academic activities that can serve to broaden their vision in related research fields.

The PhD programme offered by the Division is highly research-oriented. All doctoral students will undertake their research projects on specific topics and write their dissertations under the guidance of their supervisors. They have to fulfill the qualifying examination requirements. They also have to attend seminars within the normative study years and to take four to six courses which are specially designed for them. The Department expects our doctoral students

to continue their career in the field of higher education and research upon the graduation.

文化研究哲學博士課程旨在鼓勵學生探討人員、思想、商品、資本的跨國流動與匯聚,與此同時促進本地社區面對新社會政治條件帶來的需求與挑戰。

文化研究強調跨科際對話,以及學術方法之間的流動性;儘管如此也正因如此,本課程發展出獨有特色,當中研究範圍包括:藝術與政治、華人社會、創意產業、空間的文化演繹、文化管理、文化現代性、文化政治、數位文化、田野研究、電影研究、女性主義、性與性別、新媒體、表演研究及視覺文化研究。

PhD in Cultural Studies

Our research programme is designed to encourage students to explore the confluence of the transnational flows of people, ideas, commodities, and capital, while at the same time to facilitate local communities to face up to the demands and challenges brought about by the new socio-political conditions.

Our programme is committed to training students to analyze texts contextually, paying special attention to their variant contemporary forms, questioning how meanings are produced, mediated, circulated, and received in the various dynamic and fluid cultural fields. We are sensitive to cultural manifestations in different local environments, but we are also committed to examining how transcultural forces operate across cultures through the variables of gender, sexuality, class, race, ethnicity, and age. Pedagogically, we acknowledge cultural differences; we also believe in the polysemous nature of signs. Therefore, we are extremely cautious and critical of the manipulation of meaning productions by different kinds of forces. We also emphasize self-reflexivity, constantly encouraging students to reflect on their own prejudices and cultural experiences.

Despite and because of Cultural Studies' emphasis on interdisciplinary dialogues and the fluidity of academic approaches, our programme develops its own specific profile. The strengths of our programme include Arts ad Politics, Chinese Societies, Creative Industries, Cultural Interpretation of Space, Cultural Management, Cultural Modernity, Cultural Politics, Digital Culture, Ethnographic Study, Film Studies, Feminisms, Gender and Sexualities, New Media, Performance Studies and Visual Culture Studies.

概覽、展望及使命

藝術系前身為兩年制之藝術專修科,成立於 1957年農圃道時代的新亞書院。1963年10 月香港中文大學成立,新亞書院為成員書院 之一,藝術系成為香港第一個提供視覺藝術 專上教育的學系。

藝術系以發揚中國藝術與文化,探索現代藝術潮流與發展為教育宗旨。隨著藝術愈趨國際化,本系的課程不斷更新,力求使藝術創作和藝術史研習與時代接軌。這樣糅合傳統、現代、國際性及當代性的宏觀取向,最能體現本系於本地專上教育中的獨特性。

中國藝術史哲學博士課程

藝術學部分別於1982 -83年創立哲學碩士課程及於1991-92創立博士課程。該兩個課程於2004-05年改為哲學碩士/博士銜接完。此課程的設立,將「發揚中國傳統文化」的創系使命,提昇至更高層次。課程的宗治學術則練,以進行目的時代,尤重於中國藝術歷史包刻,將下發,大重於會畫、當代藝術、考古、給畫數藝術及當學術與文化領域。



Background, Mission and Vision

The Department of Fine Arts was founded in 1957. Initially known as Fine Arts Specialized Training Programme, it began as a two-year curriculum of study launched at New Asia College at Farm Road. When the Chinese University of Hong Kong was established in October of 1963, New Asia College was one of the University's constituent colleges. The Department of Fine Arts became the first tertiary institute to offer courses on studio practice and history of visual arts in Hong Kong.

Since its inception, the Department has promoted the study of Chinese art and culture. It has also been dedicated to an exploration of modern and contemporary artistic trends. As the arts have become increasingly internationalized, the Department has revised its curriculum in order to better bridge the connections between contemporary Chinese and Western studio and art history. It is this all-inclusive approach to Chinese art and culture—traditional, modern, international, and contemporary—that gives our Department its progressive and innovative character.

Doctor of Philosophy Programme in History of Chinese Art

The Division of Fine Arts under the Department offers the MPhil Programme and the PhD Programme that were respectively launched in 1982-83 and 1991-92. The two Programmes were converted to an articulated MPhil-PhD Programme in 2004-05. The establishment of this postgraduate programme marked a significant advancement of research on Chinese art and culture. The programme aims to provide quality academic training for conducting advanced researches into especially Chinese art history, including traditional Chinese art,

archeological art, painting, calligraphy, seal carving, ceramics, jades, bronzes, Daoist art and contemporary art, the Programme aims to produce talents who can contribute to the academic and cultural circles both locally and internationally.

The specialization in Chinese art history has been a strategic move to take advantage of the geographical and cultural position enjoyed by Hong Kong and to realize the University's as well as the Division's visions and goals with regard to the advancement of Chinese studies.

藉著老師的努力,本學部無可置疑地於香港的中國藝術史研究及藝術術研究方面取得領先地位,並且是亞洲的重要中心之一。因著本系在藝術基礎及高等教育、藝術和文化政策的制定、藝術宣傳等其他方面的貢獻,其影響力並不僅限於學界和藝術界,另對社會亦有著廣泛的影響力。

簡介

歷史學注重對人類社會整體的關注,它帶我們遊走於天、人、古、今之間;也領我們進入世界文明的廣闊天地中,激發我們對人類前途的反思,歷史學對其他學科的啟發性即在於此。

香港中文大學歷史系在一甲子前諸先賢建立的基礎上發展至今,現已成為亞太區內歷史研究的重鎮之一。本系一直強調課程的平衡性和兼容性,在學生選題方面重視國別史的實證訓練以及專題史的深究。同時,提倡多元化學風、學生本位培訓、經世致用史識以及跨文化環球視野。近年在開拓比較史和公眾史領域的同時,我們也尋求中國史研究範式上的突破,力求兼備以下的特色: 扎實根基、長程視野、宏觀比照、公共關懷。

歷史學部研究式課程

歷史學部開辦的研究式課程包括哲學碩士及哲學博士課程,課程涵蓋的專研範圍包括中國古代、近代及近世史、古代及近世世界史、近代世界史、香港史、比較史,以及公眾歷史。

歷史哲學博士學位課程

歷史哲學博士課程為本學部最高級研究式學位課程,為合資格的學生提供具世界先進水準的嚴謹學術訓練。全讀制常規修業期為36個月。合資格的博士候選人須提交論文以及通過口試答辯。博士生並須證明具有於中英文以外的第三語文能力。

Introduction

When History takes us to travel between heaven and earth, past and present, and from one civilization to the other, we learn where we are from and where we are heading for. Through these journeys, we see the human world as a whole in its fullness. Its holistic concern distinguishes History from other academic disciplines, and it is this feature of History that has stimulated scholars in other fields.

The Department of History has evolved on the foundation laid by the first generation of great masters and become one of the leading centres of historical studies in the Asia-Pacific region. All along we have emphasized a balanced, diversified and inclusive curriculum. We continue to provide solid training for empirical study of national history and in-depth study of topical history; meanwhile we have been committed in developing the areas of teaching and research in comparative history and public history. These new areas underscore the unique characteristics of cosmopolitanism and public concerns in Hong Kong's higher education. Our idea is to encompass the following as our features: solid foundational training, longue durée view, comparative perspective and public concern.

The Research Postgraduate Programmes of the Graduate Division of History

The postgraduate programmes of PhD in History and MPhil in History are research oriented higher degree programmes offered by the Graduate Division of History. Fields of specialization includes: History of Traditional China, early Modern and Modern China, Pre-modern and Modern World History, History of Hong Kong, Comparative History, and Public History.

The Programme of PhD in History

The programme of PhD in History is the highest research-oriented degree programme to provide qualified students with rigorous academic training of advanced world levels. The normative period of study is 36 months for full-time students. Qualified candidates are required to submit a research thesis and undergo an oral examination. Students are expected to show competence in a third language other than English and Chinese.

Research Information

The research activities of the Division of Japanese Studies (JAS) can be subdivided into the following four areas of concentration: (1) history, culture and society, (2) literature, art and film (3) politics, economy and business and (4) language and linguistics. In all four areas, the Division emphasizes original research that aims to advance scholarly knowledge. Although the four concentrations reflect professional and disciplinary boundaries, the faculty members embrace the spirit of interdisciplinary research. In short, the ongoing research activities of the faculty members reflect the strategic emphasis that JAS places on research that has the potential for challenging intellectual paradigms, opening new fields of investigation, and introducing innovative models of expression.

Research Programme in Japanese Studies

The objective of the M.Phil.-Ph.D. Articulated Programme in Japanese Studies is to encourage the integration of teaching and research in Japanese studies at an advanced level. It aims to allow students to integrate different disciplinary and methodological approaches for the advancement of Japanese studies. The Programme will equip students with the necessary theoretical knowledge and research skills to allow intellectual development and critical scholarship on Japan, Japan-China and Japan-Hong Kong cultural studies. The Programme builds on the Department's proven track record in graduate training in historical and contemporary studies of Japan, thereby contributing to the field of Japanese studies. The integration of these skills shall be reflected in the Ph.D. course of study as well as in the students' theses.

Graduates of the programme will have acquired broad-based knowledge of Japan as well as expertise in one of the following fields of specialization: anthropology of Japan, Japanese popular culture, Japanese linguistics, history of Sino-Japanese relations, Japan-Hong Kong relations, or Japanese intellectual history. They will have developed the skills to conduct research at an advanced level, and will have produced a thesis based on original research that contributes to Japanese studies. They will have developed the oral presentation skills to fully explain their research aims, methodologies, and conclusions, and will be able to defend their research claims when questioned by experts. They will have the ability to present their findings at international conferences.

簡介

語言學及現代語言學學系致力於語言研究, 對語言這個大腦組成部分進行科學探索。本 學部著重跨學科的研究及訓練,吸取語言學 相關學科(如哲學、心理學、認知神經科 學、工程學和教育學等)的知識和方法,引 導學生深入研究語言結構、語言獲得及語言 使用,拓展這些方面的知識。

本學部教師的研究範圍,主要分五個主要發 展方向:理論及比較語言學-通過跨語言的 比較方法,結合語言學理論來研究現代語 言,以中國境內語言為重點;語言獲得-包 括一語獲得、二語獲得、雙語獲得及手語獲 得;雙語研究-探討雙語及多語獲得和其過 程;手語語言學一運用當代語言學理論來研 究以手勢和視覺為主要媒介的語言;語言神 經科學和語言障礙一通過探討正常與非典型 的語言發展狀況,探索語言和大腦的關係。 這五個領域為當今語言學的重要學科分支, 並與心理學、言語聽覺科學、計算機科學、 訊息系統工程學、教育學和醫學等其他學科 交叉,具有跨學科研究的潛力。

本學部的語言學博士課程側重語言學核心理 論的基礎訓練,要求同學進行原創性研究, 對語言和思維的本質有所發現。本系鼓勵同 學以普通語言學的理論和方法學對香港、中 國和亞太地區的語言現象進行研究。本系博 士畢業生的論文,深入探討香港及鄰近地區 的語言,結合語言結構、語言獲得和語言使 用的相關理論進行跨語言比較,以揭示語言 的深層規律。

Introduction

The Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages is committed to the scientific study of language as an integral part of mind. We emphasize interdisciplinary research and training that draws on knowledge and methods from a wide range of related disciplines such as philosophy, psychology, cognitive neuroscience, engineering, and education, with the goal of nurturing scholarship and advancing knowledge of language, its structure, use and acquisition.

Linguists of the Division research actively on five strategic areas of development: Theoretical and Comparative Linguistics, integrating linguistics theories with the study of Modern Languages from a cross-linguistic, comparative perspective, and with a focus on the languages of China; Language Acquisition which encompasses first language acquisition, second language acquisition, bilingual acquisition and sign language acquisition; Bilingualism which investigates the acquisition and processing of two or more languages: Sign Linguistics which encourages the extension of contemporary linguistic theories to cover languages in the manual-visual modality; and Neuroscience of Language and Language Disorders, investigating the relationship between language and the brain through examining typical and atypical development across the life span. These five areas represent the major new sub-disciplines in the field of Linguistics, having great potential for collaborative research with other disciplines such as Psychology, Speech and Hearing Science, Computer Science, Information and Systems Engineering, Education and Medicine.

Our PhD programme emphasizes foundational training in the core areas of linguistic theory, and original research that sheds light on the properties of language and mind. We encourage research into different language phenomena pertinent to Hong Kong, China and the Asian-Pacific region, with emphasis on general theory and methodology. The research theses completed at this department aim to unravel underlying regularities by integrating general theories of language structure, language acquisition and language use with the in-depth study of the languages of Hong Kong and the region from a comparative perspective.

Introduction

Established in 1965, the Department of Music of CUHK has established an international reputation for the quality of its contributions to the teaching of and research into music. Our faculty and alumni have assumed significant leadership roles in local, regional and international scholarly organizations, and their academic attainments have brought both our Department and the University recognition throughout the scholarly musical community as a center of research excellence.

Research Postgraduate Programmes

Our research postgraduate degree programmes in music are prided with the longest history and also the largest intake amongst similar programmes in Hong Kong. The research activities of the Department of Music can be subdivided into four areas of concentration: (1) Composition, (2) Ethnomusicology / Chinese music, (3) Historical Musicology, and (4) Theory. Although the four concentrations reflect recognized professional boundaries, the faculty as a whole embraces the spirit of interdisciplinary research and is actively engaged in diverse modes of scholarly inquiry. In keeping with international practice, postgraduate studies in composition lead towards the professional degree titles of MMus and DMus, while that in the other three research concentrations, ethnomusicology, historical musicology and theory, lead towards the MPhil and PhD.

Our research postgraduate students, in addition to formal courses, have many other opportunities to become exposed to the latest academic research in music. The departmental research forum series offers a platform for faculty and PhD students to present their work in progress, and the colloquium series features guest lectures by international scholars on a regular basis. Faculty- and University-wide interdisciplinary lectures, forums and conferences, and exchange opportunities are also available.

簡介

香港中文大學哲學系歷史悠久,可追溯至一 九四九年新亞書院創校時成立之哲學教育 系。中大哲學系早年着重於中國哲學之研 究,後逐漸發展及西方哲學,包羅東西方哲 學的各主要領域,務求提供全面而平衡的課 程。由系內同寅領導的中國哲學與文化研究 中心及鄭承隆基金亞洲現象學中心,積極籌 辦學術活動及出版研究成果,乃東亞區內最 活躍的教研中心。本系教員均學有專精,來 自世界各地不同知名學府,涵蓋分析哲學、 中國哲學、德國哲學、法國哲學、現象學、 社會政治哲學及倫理學等不同領域。本着香 港於歷史、文化及地緣上的獨特優勢,中大 哲學系亦着力推動中、西哲學的比較研究。 而哲學學部的哲學博士課程既符合國際學術 水平,亦兼顧對中國及地區議題的關注。

課程

本學部課程中英雙語並重,哲學博士課程的 常規修業期為三十六個月,最高修業期限為 八十四個月。

第三語言要求

研究生須修讀最少九個學分的第三語文科目 (中、英文以外)。在其他院校取得之相關語 文科目學分,若經學部審核批准,可予確 認。

課業

研究生須於首兩年修讀「研究與寫作」(一) 及(二)、「研習指導」及兩次修讀「哲學問題特別專題研討」、另加兩門研究院課,共十一個學分。此外,研究生須於第三年修讀「論文寫作」(一)及(二)、共六學分。

Introduction

The Department of Philosophy at CUHK, tracing its history back to 1949, is the oldest philosophy department in Hong Kong. Specialized in Chinese philosophy in its early days, the Department has over the years developed a broad and balanced curriculum encompassing a variety of philosophical fields in both the Eastern and Western traditions. Backed by a strong faculty drawn from prestigious universities worldwide and two research centres (the Research Centre for Chinese Philosophy and Culture and the Edwin Cheng Foundation Asian Centre for Phenomenology), the Department is a vibrant venue in East Asia for conducting outstanding research in a variety of philosophical fields, such as analytic philosophy, Chinese philosophy, German and French philosophy, phenomenology, social and political philosophy, and ethics. With its unique cultural and historical heritage and geographical location, the Division also strives to promote Chinese-Western comparative philosophy as a central theme for research and scholarly activities. It takes pride in providing a PhD programme that meet international standards while maintaining national and regional relevance.

Programmes

We offer a bilingual programme in which both Chinese and English can be used in teaching and research.

Normative period of study: 36 months; Maximum period of study: 84 months

Third Language requirement

Students are required to complete a minimum of 9 units of third language courses (apart from Chinese and English). Subject to the approval of the Division, credits earned for appropriate language courses from other institutions may be recognized.

Coursework

Students are required to complete a minimum of 11 units of seminar courses within the first two years of study, including

- Research Methodology Seminar I & II (2 units)
- Guided Study (1 unit)
- Special Seminar on Selected Philosophical Issues (twice, 2 units)
- Elective courses (6 units)

In addition to the courses listed above, students are required to register Thesis Writing I & II (6 units) in the third year of study.
