Art of CUHK 2018 Phase II

Art of CUHK 2018 Phase II will be starting on 1 July 2018. Five exhibitions curated by graduates, students and artists will be happening at phase II.

The graduates of the Master of Arts in Fine Arts (MAFA) this year will present **The Happiness as a Stranger** at Gallery I, Art Museum. The theme of the exhibition aims to channel the ideas and concepts of Albert Camus's Absurd and express it through art. Twenty graduates distanced themselves from the world in order to free them of the Absurd and through that, examined self and consciousness, semiotics, love and human relationships, and society. These pieces are a reflection of their experiences over the past two years. Below is the introduction of artworks from two MAFA graduates.

Another joint exhibition, **Creation in Progress** organized by twelve MAFA Year 1 students, will exhibit their results of learning or the learning process of creation. Art is the invisible-hands which pulls them together, making them continue to create, and to keep the state of "creation in progress."


The theme of annual invitational exhibition is **ON DRAWING** which will be shown at Hui Gallery, New Asia College. The traditional form of art is immersing into colossal dimension in the hyperdigitalised era. With the collaboration of research practices on drawing in the manner of experimental and global approach of Zurich University of the Arts and School of Art, RMIT University, the two groups of artists will create dialogues in exploring the boundlessness of drawing in.

Chinese Art Exhibition by FAA Part-time Lecturers will be exhibited at Sir Run Run Shaw Hall Foyer, CUHK. This exhibition is dedicated to the achievements in the art field of the five artists/ part-time teachers. Their work presents their direction for teaching traditional Chinese art- not merely to pass down technique and theories, but as an inspiration to students about the many possibilities of art. The works of these five artists/teachers covers the exploration of traditional language and the techniques of brush and ink, which also reflect the artists' response to the living experience in contemporary society; bringing together traditional art form and modern life.

Last but not least, **Reading [Continues Tense]** will be exhibited on 2/f and 3/f of Wan Chai Joint Publishing. The exhibition, based upon the subject of reading, will be a collaboration of five MAFA Year One students. Another joint exhibition **LAAM** by Eric Lai Wai Lam and Tong Kam Ting will also be shown at Yuen Long Joint Publishing. Blues is a music genre which first related to the shouting voice or working song of African Americans during their work on the fields. Without any background music, harmony or format, blues is simple, but emotional. Through using ink and water as medium, the artists attempt to express their inner emotions as well as step out of the strict boundary of traditional Chinese painting by a more direct and simple way in response to the contemporary context.
