

MTR Student Travel Scheme 2020/21

To enjoy concessionary MTR fares, students are required to use a Personalised Octopus with valid “Student Status”.

1) Eligibility

The applicant must be a student conforming to the following definitions:

“Student” - any person aged between 12 and 25 who is currently enrolled on a full-time day course offered by an acceptable institution in Hong Kong.

“Full-time day course” - a day-time course which normally requires the participant to attend an acceptable local institution not less than 20 hours of academic instruction each week for 30 weeks or more in an academic year.

2) Application Fee

- ✧ New application: HK\$90 (including HK\$50 refundable Octopus deposit)
- ✧ Activation/Renewal of “Student Status” on a Personalised Octopus: HK\$20

3) Acquisition of Application Form

4) Verification of Student Status

There are **TWO methods** of verification of student status.

- i) Students may go to their **respective department or office as listed below** for verification and endorsement on the application form.

- ii) Students may obtain an **e-student identity certificate** from department/office. Please contact the **respective department or office in advance** for obtaining the e-certificate.

5) Application Procedures and Collection of a Personalised Octopus with “Student Status”

- ✧ Students should submit the application forms with department/office endorsement **or** e-student identity certificate provided by department/office to any MTR Customer Service Centre (except Airport Express stations, Lo Wu, Lok Ma Chau, Racecourse, Disneyland Resort, Sunny Bay, Wong Chuk Hang, Lei Tung, South Horizons, Hin Keng and Kai Tak stations). A receipt will be issued when students submit their application form and they can present the receipt for buying a “Temporary Student Octopus”.
- ✧ Students should collect the Personalised Octopus with “Student Status” **at the distribution counter of the designated**

station they have selected in the application form at specific time period.

6) **Application for Activation / Renewal of “Student Status” on a Personalised Octopus**

- ✧ Students should submit the application forms with department/office endorsement **or** e-student identity certificate provided by department/office to any MTR Customer Service Centre (except Airport Express stations, Lo Wu, Lok Ma Chau, Racecourse, Disneyland Resort, Sunny Bay, Wong Chuk Hang, Lei Tung, South Horizons, Hin Keng and Kai Tak stations).
- ✧ A confirmation email with instructions on renewal of student status and application fee payment will be sent to successful applicants by MTR.

7) **Guidelines for Completing the Application Form**

- ✧ Application form must be printed on A4 size white paper.
- ✧ Each application form downloaded from the MTR website carries a unique serial number to facilitate the application for "MTR Student Travel Scheme (2020/2021)". The downloaded application form is **for one applicant's** use only. Any type of copying or reproduction of the downloaded application form will not be accepted.

- ✧ Application Form (Page 1)
 - Part B “School Name”: Students should fill in “**The Chinese University of Hong Kong**”.
 - Part B “School Address”: The address is “**Shatin, New Territories**”.
 - Part B “Email Address”: Students should fill in the email address for entering online renewal procedures.
