Student Residence Bursary Scheme 2020/21

Guidelines for Applicants

In order to help those needy students who are not able to benefit substantially from the Community Care Fund (CCF) hostel subsidy, the CUHK Student Residence Bursary Scheme is open for application.

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for the CUHK Student Residence Bursary 2020/21, applicants must:

- 1. be local full-time undergraduate students;
- 2. be registered residents of the hostel and have resided in hostel for at least 75% of the time of the term (based on the availability of the hostels for students);
- 3. have average monthly household income (during 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020) lower than the median of the monthly household income published in the most recent Quarterly Report on General Household Survey by the Census and Statistics Department as follows:

Household Size	Monthly Household Income ^
1 person	\$10,000
2 persons	\$20,700
3 persons	\$34,400
4 persons	\$45,000
5 persons	\$45,500
6 persons or more	\$46,200

4. be not able to benefit from CCF hostel subsidy or receive less than \$1,480 per term under the CCF hostel subsidy.

Important Notes

- 1. Students whose family received Comprehensive Social Security Assistance during the said period are, in general, eligible for the maximum CCF hostel subsidy*. Therefore, they need **NOT** submit applications for CUHK Student Residence Bursary.
 - * Still subject to the individual assessment by the Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency
- 2. CCF hostel subsidy will be automatically considered under the Tertiary Student Finance Scheme (TSFS) application, and therefore no separate application for the CCF hostel subsidy is required. Amount of Bursary

- 1. For eligible needy students who are not able to benefit from CCF hostel subsidy, the value of each bursary will be \$1,480 per term.
- 2. For eligible needy students who receive less than \$1,480 per term under CCF hostel subsidy, the value of each bursary will be the difference between \$1,480 and the approved amount of CCF hostel subsidy.

Application Procedures

Submission of **Online** Application

- 1. Eligible students who live in hostel for the first term or the whole year should submit their online application in Chinese University Student Information System (CUSIS) (Website: http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/cusis; MyCUHK > Click 'CUSIS' icon > Click 'Scholarships and Financial Aid' icon > Select 'Online Application Form' > Public Application > click the magnifying glass to select "Student Residence Bursary") by 30 November 2020. For students who live in hostel for the second term only, they should submit their applications by 31 March 2021. Students who live in hostel for the whole year but submit their applications in the second term will only receive the residence bursary for the second term even if they are eligible.
- 2. For students who have applied for University Bursaries and Loans (UBL) 2020/21, the saved data for family income, bank account details and hostel address on the UBL online application form will be automatically shared to the corresponding fields of the Student Residence Bursary Scheme online application form. Students can still make necessary amendments on the data, if any.

Submission of Documentary Proofs to College

- 3. After submission of the online application, applicants should submit the documentary proofs of monthly income of all members in the family (e.g. salary statement, employer's return of remuneration and pensions, bank account statement indicating salary payments, profit and loss account etc.) for the period from 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020. Applicants should print out Section 7 of the online application form and submit together with the supporting documents to their respective College on or before the application deadline. The application deadline for the first term / whole year residency bursary is 30 November 2020 whereas for the second term is 31 March 2021. For those who have applied for UBL, they need NOT submit supporting documents to the College.
- 4. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Application Result

Applicants will be informed of the results of 1st term student residence bursary in March 2021 while 2nd term in August 2021 after the result announcement of the CCF hostel subsidy.
