

Shaw College, The Chinese University of Hong Kong Anti-epidemic Relief Grant Scheme

Purpose

The COVID-19 epidemic has deeply plagued global economy, many low income families have been facing challenges with their livings during this period. The Shaw College Anti-epidemic Relief Grant Scheme was established to provide one-off grant to support students of Shaw College whose families are in urgent financial need.

Selection Criteria

The candidates should be:

- 1. the students of Shaw College who are pursuing a full time undergraduate programme (excluding exchange students);
- 2. in financial hardship which was caused or impacted by the COVID-19 epidemic, such as:
 - unemployment of family member(s)
 - underemployment of family member(s)
 - any other personal or family's special circumstances

Candidates who DID NOT receive financial assistance in 2020/21 from a) CUHK Bursary; b) Shaw College Bursary; c) CUHK Perseverance Bursary; and d) Tertiary Student Finance Scheme (TSFS) administered by the Student Finance Office would be given higher priority in the consideration.

Amount of Grant per student

The amount for each grant shall not exceed HK\$10,000.

Application Guidelines

- 1. Submit the application form at https://doud.itsc.cuhk.edu.hk/webform/view.php?id=12480733
- 2. ONE page of personal statement on "How would the Shaw College Anti-epidemic Grant Scheme help you?"
- 3. Provide sufficient supporting documents showing the financial hardship impacted by COVID-19, e.g. proof of unemployment.
- 4. All supporting documents should be in ONE pdf file and file size is limited to 10MB.
