


Getting Connected to eduroam / Universities via CSL / Universities via Y5ZONE through a 802 dot1x connection - Windows Users

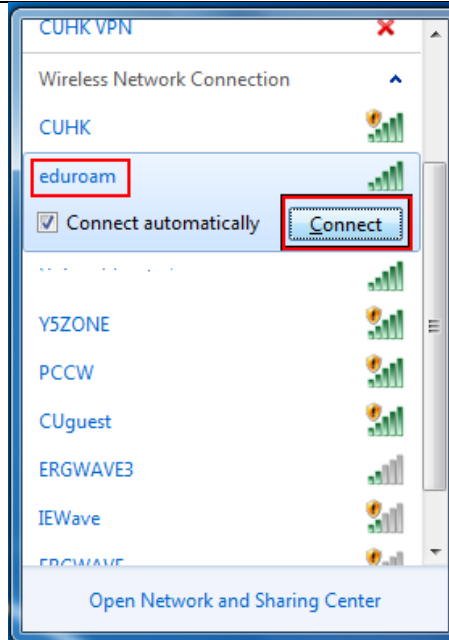

A. Detect and Connect to eduroam / Universities via CSL / Universities via Y5ZONE

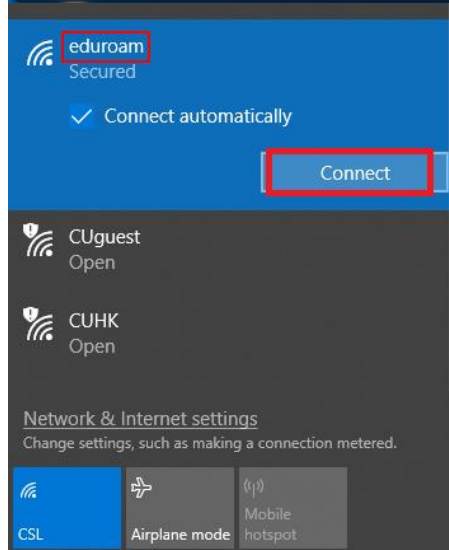
<p>1. Turn on the Wi-Fi function of your computer (please refer to your computer's user manual for more details)</p> <p>Click the Wi-Fi icon on the system tray</p>

2. You should see the available wireless networks in the list.

Click **Refresh network list** if you cannot find **eduroam** (or **Universities via CSL** or **Universities via Y5ZONE**) in the list.



3. Choose **eduroam** (or **Universities via CSL** or **Universities via Y5ZONE**) and then click **Connect**.




4. In the **Network Authentication** window, enter the following.

- **User name**

- **Password**




