Use Policies and Guidelines of CUHK Wi-Fi Service

The University Information Technology Services Centre (ITSC) has implemented a Wi-Fi service (SSID=CUHK or CUHKa) for all CUHK staft and students. Note:

 To access the CUHK Wi-Fi Service, you should have read and agreed to the policies and guidelines published at <u>http://www.cuhk.edu.hk/itsc/about/wlan_policy.html</u>.

- Except for the initial CWEM authentication, all the data are transferred in plain text without encryption. You should therefore avoid accessing sites that ask for your sensitive / personal information (such as online banking) when using it.
- For a secured connection or accessing some University restricted websites (e.g.Anti-virus Software Download page), you should run a VPN connection additionally over this Wi-Fi service.
- 4. Smartphone users should temporarily disable mobile data services such as GPRS, EDGE, UMTS or HSDPA provided by your mobile operator. This helps to avoid the associated service charge from your mobile operator caused by the accidental change of Internet access from the campus free Wi-Fi connections to mobile data services when the Wi-Fi signal becomes weak or inaccessible.
