





# Connect/ Use to CUHK / CUHKa Wi-Fi Service on Mac


(This user guide is applicable to OS X 10.7 or above)

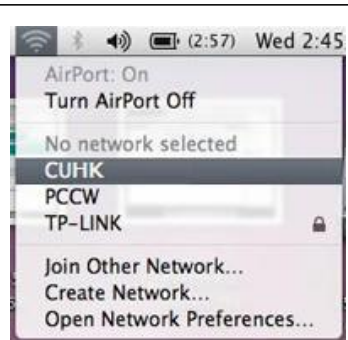




### A. Detect a CUHK/CUHKa Hotspot Connection

<p>1. Choose <b>Apple menu</b>  and select <b>System Preferences</b>.</p>	
<p>2. Double-click the <b>Network</b> icon.</p>	
<p>3. In the left menu column, choose <b>Wi-Fi</b>. Then click <b>Turn Wi-Fi On</b> on the right.</p> <p>When the status changes to <b>On</b>, close the window.</p>	

4. Click the **Wi-Fi icon**  in the top menu bar. Select **CUHK / CUHKa** from the available wireless networks.



## B. Connect to CUHK Wi-Fi Service

<p>1. Open a web browser and visit any webpage. <i>You may see a message box pop out.</i></p> <p>Click <b>Continue</b>.</p> <p>Note: You can browse CUHK homepage (<a href="http://www.cuhk.edu.hk">http://www.cuhk.edu.hk</a>) without logging</p>	
<p>2. You will be re-directed to <b>Use Policies and Guidelines of CUHK Wi-Fi Service</b>. Click <b>Accept</b> to continue.</p>	
<p>3. At Login to CUHK Wi-Fi Service page, enter your <b>Computing ID*</b> and your <b>OnePass (CWEM) password</b>. Then, click <b>Log In</b>.</p> <p>*Computing ID:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• s1155xxxxxx for students</li> <li>• bxxxxxx for staff</li> </ul>	
<p>4. A window showing "<b>Login successful</b>" will pop up.</p> <p>And you may enjoy CUHK Wi-Fi service from now on.</p>
