





Getting Connected to Y5ZONE Wi-Fi Service - iPhone

A. Detect and Connect to Y5ZONE Wi-Fi Service

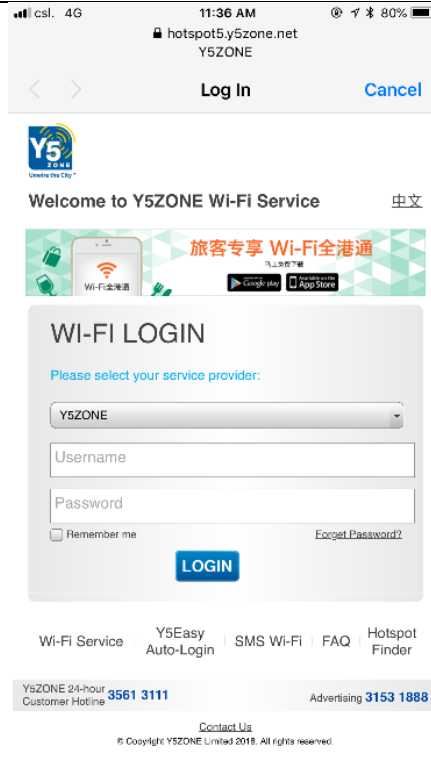

3. After connect, it will redirect users to the page of Y5ZONE Login Page.

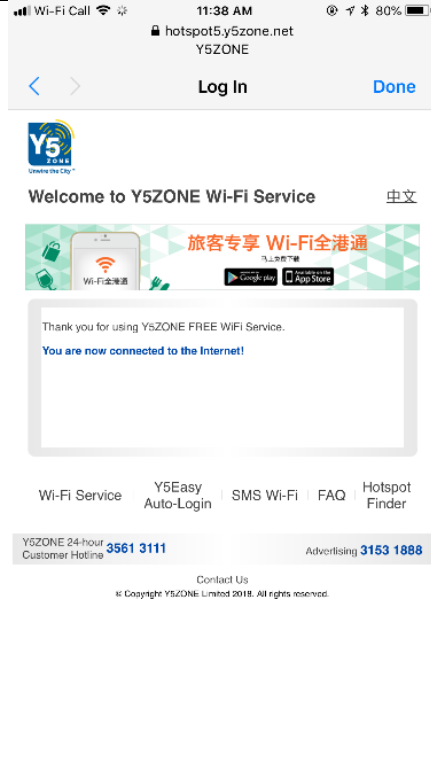
4. Enter the following:

- **Username**
your_Computing_ID@cuhk.edu.hk
(e.g. s001234@cuhk.edu.hk)
- **Password**
the password you have created for this programme




Then click "Login".



5. After successful login, you will see the message "You are now connected to the internet!"

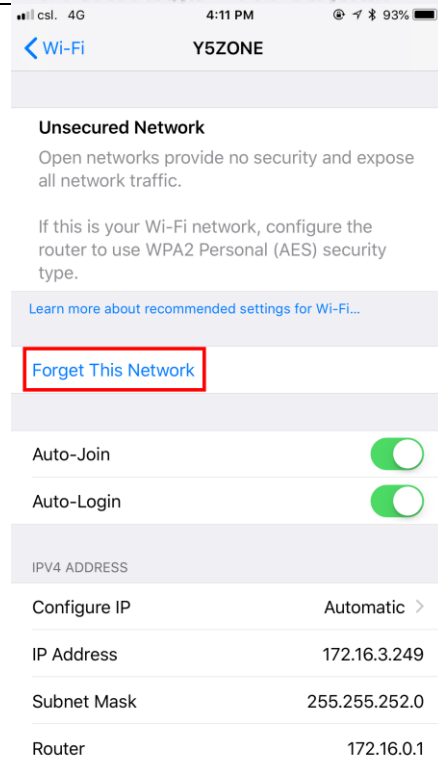


B. Disconnect from Y5ZONE Wi-Fi Service
