### 1. Major Programme:

Upon completing the programme, students will have:

- (1) attained the ability to think critically and express their views in oral and written form using well constructed arguments and by presenting evidence
- (2) demonstrated a broad understanding of Japanese society and culture in domestic, regional and global contexts
- (3) demonstrated a mastery of a special topic within Japanese studies based on original data collection and a comprehensive survey of relevant academic literature
- (4) attained the ability to plan and execute a complex, long-term research project

- (5) attained the ability to draw upon multiple disciplinary perspectives and approaches to analyze Japan and their own society
- (6) attained the ability to identify and analyze Japanese-language resources for research purposes
- (7) attained the ability to communicate effectively using Japanese language in the appropriate social and cultural contexts
- (8) attained the ability to use Japanese language at both concrete and abstract levels to express ideas and opinions
- (9) developed inter-cultural sensitivity on personal and intellectual levels
- (10) developed the skills and attitudes that facilitate life-long learning
