Abstract:

“State sovereignty” is now more often heard and such claim is a typical mode of the sovereign state system which makes the rules of game in the international politics. Regionalism is proposed as a supplement, not as an alternative, to the existing international politics and EU has proven to be a change of the rules of game. This lecture provides a vision for regional cooperation and integration in East Asia.

Speaker Biography:

After serving as a career diplomat, Consul-General to Hong Kong (2004-6) and Ambassador to Greece (2006-10), he joined CUHK in 2010 and is now teaching on regionalism of East Asia.
