In view of Coronavirus outbreak, the TA who is responsible for the assignments would like to draw your attention to the following issues:

- 1. Until further notice, when you want to submit your assignments, you are strongly encouraged to submit it electronically by:
 - a. Submit a single pdf file. If you have no idea how to make one, then you may try the following approach:
 - Take photos of your papers by smart phone
 - Search "image to pdf" and you should be able to find some free online tools
 - b. Name your file "Hw(no. of assigment) (your name)". For example, "Hw3 Isaac Newton". 1
 - c. Zip your file with a password. Use your student id (1155??????) as the default password. You can also use another stronger password; just send an email to notify me.
 - d. Upload your password-protected file to this shared folder.²³ This online folder is also password protected. The password is of length 10 and it is formed by concatenating those initial prime numbers one by one.
 - e. Done. You need not send an email to me after submission, and I will not send an acknowledgement to you.
 - f. Note that this practice is not for environmental friendly propose, as I will still print your pdf out. Therefore, for saving ink, I hope you try to make a white-background document.
- 2. I will not return the marked assignment papers to you at the moment (I think currently you may not like to touch them too). Let's wait for a while.

All of the above are due to my personal thought and action only. They are subjective and not representative. I hope they are good.
