Enlistment of Volunteers to serve as Resident Tutors for UC Student Hostels

United College is now inviting volunteers from University staff and postgraduate students, who are interested in the promotion of experiential learning amongst students and the enrichment of hostel life, to serve as Resident Tutors (住校導師) for the academic year 2021-2022.

The Resident Tutors will assist the College and/or the Warden to discharge the following duties:

- 1. To assist in the College's non-formal and general education initiatives.
- 2. To arrange and conduct seminars and tutorials for the students.
- 3. To assist the College and the Residents' Associations in organising their various functions and activities, including but not confined to orientation programmes and high-table dinners.
- 4. To receive training in psychological counselling and in turn to provide general counselling and guidance to the residents and when necessary, to refer them to the appropriate College or University units for follow-up action.
- 5. To be responsible for general hostel management including for example, maintenance of floor security and inspection for room cleanliness and disorderly or illegal activities.
- 6. To serve as an intermediary between hostel management and the resident students and to help the Warden to maintain peace, order and good administration of the hostel.
- 7. To carry out other duties as may reasonably be assigned by the College or the Warden.

Volunteers are nominated as Resident Tutors. This is not an employment either on a full-time or part-time basis, and is not regarded as a concurrent employment with the University. There will not be any allowance/remuneration or any other employee benefits for provision of this volunteer service. The nominated Resident Tutor will be provided with a free single room in one of the United College student hostels. The nomination will last for one year and will start in August 2021, subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should be full-time staff or full-time postgraduate students at CUHK in the academic year 2021-2022, possess at least a recognized first degree. Preference will be given to those with residence experience in hostels. DUTIES OF A RESIDENT TUTOR

- 1. A resident tutor is expected to assist in the College's non-formal and general education initiatives.
- 2. A resident tutor should expect to be called upon to arrange and conduct seminars and tutorials for the students.
- 3. A resident tutor is expected to assist the College and the Residents' Associations in organising their various functions and activities, including but not confined to orientation programmes and high-table dinners.
- 4. A resident tutor is expected to receive training in psychological counselling and in turn to provide general counselling and guidance to the residents and when necessary, to refer them to the appropriate College or University units for follow-up action.
- 5. A resident tutor is expected to be responsible for general hostel management including for example, maintenance of floor security and inspection for room cleanliness and disorderly or illegal activities.
- 6. A resident tutor is expected to serve as an intermediary between hostel management and the resident students and to help the Warden to maintain peace, order and good administration of the hostel.
- 7. It is expected that a resident tutor should carry out other duties as may reasonably be assigned by the College or the Warden.

N.B. The term of office of a resident tutor usually begins on 1 August as soon as he/she is nominated by the College, and ends by 31 July in the following year. The resident tutor is expected to give one month's notice in writing to inform the College and the Warden if he/she wishes to resign.
