1. 宿舍夜話 (數碼通暫代總裁兼科技總裁鄒金根先生主講)

Hostel Night Talk (by Mr Stephen Chau, Interim CEO and Chief Technology Officer of SmarTone)



The College is honoured to have invited Mr. Stephen Chau (鄒金根先生), Interim CEO and Chief Technology Officer of SmarTone (數碼通暫代總裁兼科技總裁), to give a hostel night talk on "Challenges & Opportunities in a Rapidly Developing Industry 一個迅速發展行業的挑戰與機遇" in the evening of 17th Nov. Mr. Chau shared with participants his insights of the development of the mobile industry and internet industry, and encouraged participants to find the pinpoints through day-to-day observation which can turn out to be a great opportunity for business startup. Professor Kong-pang Pun (潘江鵬), Chairperson of College Student Hostels Committee and Warden of Student Hostel West Block, served as the moderator of the talk and Professor Rance P.L. Lee (李沛良), College Master, presented a College souvenir to Mr. Chau as a token of our appreciation.

2. Hong Kong - Tainan Cultural & Creativity Exchange Program: Pre-Trip Workshop & Field Trip in Sai Kung



Revitalization and redevelopment have been one of the most important current issues in developed cities and regions, including Hong Kong and Taiwan. The Creativity Lab has organized the Hong Kong - Tainan Cultural and Creativity Exchange Programme to help students increase their understanding and awareness towards this issue and the close relation between preservation and innovation by holding a series of activities including workshops, site visits and exchange tour to Taiwan.

The 1st pre-trip workshop was held last Saturday, 21st Nov in the Creativity Lab successfully and all participants, 18 students have attended. We have invited the Program partner from Taiwan, Professor S.N. Liou (劉世南教授) and Professor Fred C.H. Yang (楊佳翰教授), the Institute of Creativity Industry Design (創意產業研究所), National Cheng Kung University (國立成功大學) to our College and had a wonderful sharing on their experience on investigating the cultural characteristics of Hong Kong and Tainan.

The Programme leaders of our College, Professor C.Y. Chiu (趙志裕教授), College Fellow and Dean, Faculty of Social Science; and Professor Letty Y.Y. Kwan (關欣儀教授), College Member provided a detailed introduction of research methodology and analysis skills could be used in the project.



All participants and teachers went to Sai Kung for a field trip on the next day and tried to apply the skills and knowledge learnt from the workshop. Professor Annisa C.H. Lee (李賴俊卿教授), Dean of Students has also joined the tour to facilitate the whole visit.

Students has conducted interviews with people who live or work in Sai Kung. The tour and interviews were both crucial as they can truly understand the lifestyle and cultures of the locals by experiencing their daily life and meeting them face-to-face.

After the trip, all team members had joined the dinner gathering and a debrief session was held for summarizing the findings. Students shared the information they collected and fellow Professors also gave feedback on how they could manage to develop different study frameworks by compiling and studying the data in various aspects.

The field trip was educational and beneficial to students which would be very much useful for preparation of the 2nd part of the programme - Tainan exchange tour to be held in early January 2016.

5. Non-Resident Hall Activity: Terrarium Workshop 走讀生舍堂活動 - 玻璃盆景班



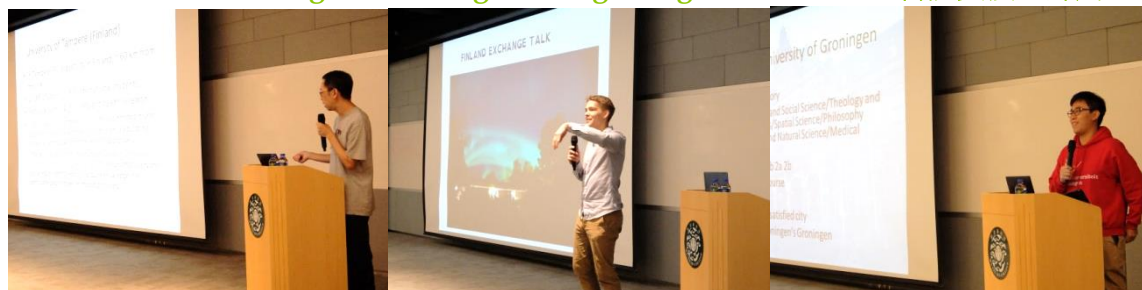

4. Innovation and Technology Scholarship Award Scheme 2016

The Innovation and Technology Scholarship Award Scheme (the Scheme) aims to provide recognition to outstanding undergraduates in universities in Hong Kong as well as opportunities to widen their international/Mainland exposure and gain industry experience. Twenty-five science undergraduates, to be nominated by the six local universities and selected by an Awardee Selection Committee of the Scheme, will each be awarded a **scholarship of up to HK\$150,000**. The Scheme comprises the following components:

- (a) Financial support for Overseas/Mainland Attachment Programme(s) between 1 June 2016 and 30 June 2017 (at least one of the attachment programmes must be longer than three weeks)
- (b) Mentorship Programme
- (c) Service Project Programme
- (d) Local Internship Programme (optional)

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

The Scheme is open to full-time, **non-final-year undergraduates** who meet the following criteria:

- Hong Kong Permanent Residents with the right of abode in Hong Kong.
- Students majoring in the University Grants Committee-funded programmes offered by the Faculty of Engineering, Medicine or Science.
- Preferably cumulative GPA of 3.3 (or equivalent) or above.
