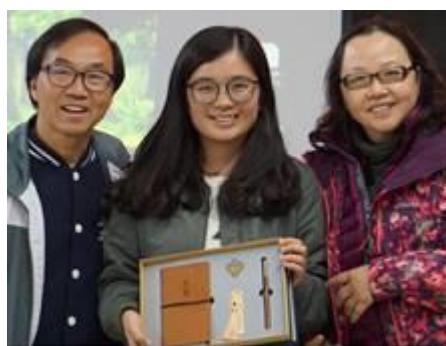

1. Yan Chak Service-Learning Programme: Service-Learning Trip to Yunnan

仁澤服務學習計劃：雲南服務學習之旅



17 Sunnies from different majors participated in the College Service-Learning Trip to Yunnan from 27th Dec 2018 to 5th Jan 2019. Led by Senior College Tutor Mr. Wak-hung Tang (鄧惠雄先生) and accompanied by a few local students and staff of Yunnan University, our students went to Dayile Village (大矣勒村) in Yunnan to organize activities for the elderly, children and the community there. Despite the adverse weather and living conditions, our students were devoted to offering services to the villagers.



For children service, the College students have planned various activities to share different values and knowledge with them. For example, they taught the children not to bully others by a short play and storytelling. They also played games and did craftworks to share values such as environmental protection and healthy diet with the children. Knowing the children always eat junk food, our students did a scientific experiment with them to show that junk food is not good for health because of the artificial pigments contained. As New Year celebration, the

Sunnies danced with the children in front of other villagers and brought laughter for everyone at the beginning of the year.



For elderly service, the Sunnies visited the homes of the elderly to teach them simple stretching exercise and conduct health assessment for them. They helped the elderly to make a memory book, and also gave handmade paper flowers and sachets with Chinese herbs to the elderly as gifts.

Although Dayile Village is a village of the Zhuang ethnic minority (the Zhuang 壯族), the new generation did not know much about the Zhuang and the problem of culture loss arises. Our students strived to help their culture preservation and gathered information of the history and traditions of the Zhuang by interviewing locals, as well as learned local arts and craftwork including embroidery, bamboo weaving and local songs. They then hosted an exhibition to share with the villagers their findings and feelings.

As invited by the villagers and social workers, our students made suggestions on environmental protection such as recycling, reducing rubbish and keeping the river clean. Our students also give advice to the social workers how they could further improve the development of the village.

Participants had a fruitful time throughout the programme. They have gained a deeper understanding to the culture of the Zhuang and the situation of the left-behind children and elderly. They also reflect on the differences between villages and cities and further ponder upon how they could help the needy more.

1. College Member Professor Ka-ming Wu Selected from Worldwide Recruitment to Join an International 10-year Collaborative Leadership Initiative



Professor Ka-ming Wu (胡嘉明教授), College Member and Associate Professor at the Department of Cultural and Religious Studies, has been selected to join [Homeward Bound](#), a social enterprise and leadership outreach initiative that aims to equip a 1,000-strong global collaboration of women with STEMM (science, technology, engineering, mathematics, medicine) backgrounds to lead, influence and contribute to policy and decision-making as it informs the future of our planet within 10 years.

Professor Wu is the only member in Hong Kong and in social science chosen, along with 94 members in the entire globe this year. The program will conclude in November 2019 with a three-week scientific research training in the Antarctica.

- 4) We will follow your preference to assign locker(s) as far as possible, subject to the number of applications.

Regulations for the Use of Lockers

1. Users should take care of their personal belongings kept in lockers. The College will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
2. Due to hygienic reasons, no food, beverages, condiments or similar items should be kept in the lockers.

3. Users are responsible for cleaning the lockers and removing all the personal belongings inside them before returning the lockers to the College. After the stipulated period of use, any leftover items inside the lockers will be disposed of without any notification (no compensation will be made for destroyed locks).
4. Deposit will be refunded by auto-pay. Students should check their bank accounts in due course.
5. Deposit will be forfeited if any damage is made or failure to clear the locker upon expiry of the period of use.
6. The College may seize the student's right to use the locker if he / she violates the regulations or misuses the locker.
7. Users are fully responsible in taking care of their lockers. To avoid any misunderstandings, users are strongly recommended to lock their lockers even if they do not leave anything inside.

5. Student Residence Bursary Scheme 2018/19 (for students who reside in hostel for the second term only)

In order to help those needy students who are not able to benefit substantially from the Community Care Fund (CCF) hostel subsidy, the CUHK Student Residence Bursary Scheme was launched in 2014/15 academic year.

Eligibilities

To be eligible to apply for the CUHK Student Residence Bursary 2018/19, applicants must:

- (1) be local full-time undergraduate students;
- (2) be registered residents of the hostel and have resided in hostel for at least 75% of the time of the term;

(3) have average monthly household income (during 1st Apr 2017 to 31st Mar 2018) lower than the median of the monthly household income published in the most recent Quarterly Report on General Household Survey by the Census and Statistics Department as follows:

<u>Household Size</u>	<u>Monthly Household Income</u>
1 person	\$8,500
2 persons	\$21,100
3 persons	\$33,100
4 persons	\$42,100
5 persons	\$43,700
6 persons or more	\$44,000

(4) be not able to benefit from CCF hostel subsidy or receive less than \$1,360 per term under the CCF hostel subsidy.

The value of bursary will be maximum \$1,360 per term. Eligible students who live in hostel for the second term only should submit their online application via CUSIS from 7th Jan to 28th Feb. Applicants are required to print out Section 7 of the online application form and submit together with supporting documents to the College Office **on or before 28th Feb 2019**. Students who reside in hostel for whole year and have submitted their applications in the first term need not submit their application again.

- the University Composition Fee;
- the College fee;
- a maintenance allowance to take care of board and lodging set each year by the Cambridge Overseas Trust and a settling-in fee;
- the cost of one return airfare between Hong Kong and the United Kingdom by the most economical route

The Scholarship shall only be awarded to the CUHK alumni who graduated within the recent 3 years (i.e. 2015, 2016 and 2017 classes). It may also be awarded to a final-year student contingent upon graduating from CUHK before taking up the Scholarship.
