**Keynote Speakers****陳健民 (Kin-Man CHAN)**

Kin-man Chan received his Ph.D. from Yale University and is currently Director of Universities Service Centre for China Studies, Director of Centre for Civil Society Studies, Associate Director of Center for Entrepreneurship, and Associate Professor of Sociology at The Chinese University of Hong Kong. He is also a visiting professor of Sociology, and Chair of International Advisory Committee, Center of Philanthropy at Sun Yat-sen University, academic advisor of China Charity and Donation Information Center under Ministry of Civil Affairs in China. He serves in the editorial boards of *Journal of Civil Society* (US), *China Non-Profit Review* (Beijing) and *Third Sector Review* (Taiwan). In Hong Kong, he is China Projects Committee member of Oxfam Hong Kong and director of Hong Kong Civic Education Foundation. He is the co-author of *Stories and Theories of Democracy (with Choy Chi Keung)*, *Contentious Views: Nine Debates that Changed Hong Kong (with Ng Shu Yui)*, *One Country Two Systems (with Tsui Sing Yan)*, *Trade Association and Social Capital (with Qiu Haixiong)* and author of *Towards Civil Society and Civil Society Perspective: Towards Good Governance*.

**张鸣 (Ming ZHANG)**

张鸣，浙江上虞人，1957年生，政治学博士，1994年考入中国人民大学历史系；1996年毕业后，留校任教。曾任中国人民大学政治系主任，现为中国人民大学国际关系学院教授、博士生导师。张鸣长在中国的“北极”北大荒。做过农工，兽医。初学农业机械，后涉历史，在吃粉笔灰之余，喜欢写点不伦不类的文字，有的被视为学术著作，有《武夫治国梦》、《乡土心 路八十年》、《乡村社会权力和文化结构的变迁》等数种，还有一些算是历史文化随笔，有《直截了当的独白》、《关于两脚羊的故事》、《历史的坏脾气》、《历史的底稿》。2012年出版新作《重说中国近代史》。

**宋永毅 (Yongyi SONG)**

宋永毅，美国加州州立大学洛杉矶分校图书馆教授。他是研究中国当代史、尤其是文化大革命的著名学者。他出版有中英文研究著作多种，有《文化大革命：目录索引，1966-1976》，（英文，哈佛大学燕京学社，1998），《文化大革命中的异端思潮，1-2》，（英文，美国 M. E. Shape Inc.，2002），《中国文化大革命历史大辞典》（英文，美国 Scarecrow Press，2006），《新编红卫兵资料，112卷》，（美国华盛顿中国资料研究中心，2002-2010）。他还是现在世界上唯一的大型中国现代政治运动史网络和光碟系列数据库的主编，现在已经出版《中国文化大革命数据库，1966-1976》、《中国反右运动数据库，1957-》（香港中文大学中国研究服务中心）和即将出版的《中国大跃进-大饥荒数据库，1958-1962》的主编。由于他的研究在保存历史真相方面的成绩，他曾荣获2004年美国“21世纪国家图书馆馆员奖”，2005年美国图书馆协会“保罗·哈德勇气奖”，2006年美国视觉艺术家协会的“言论自由奖”和2011年美国加州图书馆协会学术奖。

**Deborah Davis**

Deborah S. Davis is currently Professor of Sociology at Yale University where she has also served as Director of Academic Programs at the Yale Center for the Study of Globalization, Chair of the Department of Sociology, Chair of the Council of East Asian Studies, and co-chair of the Women's Faculty Forum.

Her primary teaching interests are historical and comparative sociology, inequality and stratification, contemporary Chinese society, and methods of fieldwork. In addition to teaching at Yale, she has led several summer fieldwork workshops where Yale students work collaboratively with students from the Chinese University of Hong Kong and China. In past summers the seminar has investigated such topics as transformations of childhood consumption, changing concepts of privacy and property rights, the uses of public space in new and old residential communities in Hong Kong and Shanghai, interaction of household and village level resources for predicting school attendance in rural Yunnan, and comparison of divorce reform in Hong Kong and Shanghai. In summer 2013 the focus will be a comparison of the moral and ethical languages of Buddhism, Christianity, and Confucianism.

Author or editor of eight books, past publications have analyzed the politics of the Cultural Revolution, Chinese family life, pension and welfare policy, consumer culture, property rights, social stratification and occupational mobility. In 2009 Stanford University Press published *Creating Wealth and Poverty in Post-Socialist China*, co-edited with Wang Feng and this year she and anthropologist Sara Friedman have completed a new volume entitled *Marriage and Sexuality in Cosmopolitan China*. In a current project with Professors Chen Juan (Hong Kong Polytechnic University) and Pierre Landry (University of Pittsburgh) she is using a 2011 survey of urban China to examine how the "penalties of rural birth" vary across time and space.

钱钢教授，香港大学新闻及传媒研究中心中国传媒研究计划主任，中国大陆著名传媒人。1953年出生于浙江杭州，1966年在读初中一年级时因文革中断学业。1969年入伍，在军队自学写作。1979年至1989年担任解放军报记者、记者处负责人，其间三度获全国优秀报告文学奖，发表于1986年的《唐山大地震》，被翻译为英、日、韩等多种文字。1989年后，钱钢离开军队，参与多家传媒的工作，包括参与创办《中国减灾报》并任执行编委（1991）、参与创办《三联生活周刊》并任执行主编（1993）、担任CCTV《新闻调查》栏目总策划（1997）、《南方周末》常务副主编（1998-2001）。钱钢近年的作品有：《大清留美幼童记》（与胡劲草合作）、《旧闻记者》、《中国传媒与政治改革》、《政治改革大博弈》（编辑并导读）、《如此盛世》，和陈婉莹共同主编的书有：《中国传媒风云录》、《中国猛博》、《中国传媒锐思录》等。2012年秋在纽约时报中文网发表系列评论《10个关键词语中的18大》。
