

Certificate Course in Medical Microbiology 2020 医学微生物学证书课程 2020 Department of Microbiology, The Chinese University of Hong Kong 香港中文大学微生物学系



Background

The Department of Microbiology has been organizing annual summer course on Medical Microbiology for young scientists from Mainland China since 1998. Two reunion conferences were held in Shanghai and Nanjing respectively in 2005 and 2007. Every year the response to this course is overwhelming. Since 2013, this course has been upgraded to a university certificate course.

Objectives

- To advance the knowledge in basic principles and contemporary techniques in medical microbiology & virology
- To understand the practice of medical microbiology & virology in a developed healthcare setting
- To enhance technical expertise in medical microbiology & virology
- To familiarize with clinical laboratory management and accreditation systems

Target Participants

This course is targeted for laboratory personnel working in the field of medical microbiology & virology in Mainland China. Applicants from other disciplines and from elsewhere may be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Study Period & Venue

10 - 23 June 2020, full-time

Entry Requirements

Applicants should possess a Bachelor of Science degree or equivalent and currently working in the relevant field. Application should be endorsed by supervisors.

Format of Teaching

Lectures, workshops, laboratory visits, demonstrations and interactive discussion

30 November 2019

Places are limited. Registration will be available on a first-come-first-served basis.

Official acceptance of registration will be issued to successful applicants in mid Dec 2019.

Application fee: HK\$100.00 (non-refundable)

Course fee: HK\$4.000.00 (accommodation fee is NOT included*)

acceptance of registration.)

Farewell dinner fee: HK\$250 (optional)
