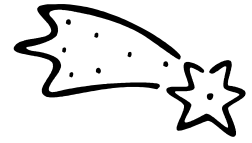
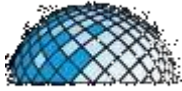

Summer Internship Programme 2019



What is it?

This program is for our students to work as teachers' aides in secondary schools (**STAR**) or student interns in the Hong Kong Space Museum, so that they can gain invaluable experience in various expertises and widen their vision. Participants will go to the particular institution and work full time under supervision.

Who are eligible to apply?

If you are a PHY undergraduate in the year 2018-2019, you are eligible to apply. You should also have a good academic record and are interested in a teaching career and/or promoting popular science. We look for motivated students who have a solid physics background, who are independent, creative, and get along well with others.

How about stipends?

Successful applicants completing the programme will be awarded a total stipend of HK\$9,500.

Participants' responsibilities

1. Successful applicants have to complete a training program before the internship starts under the supervision of the department advisors. Poor performance in the program may lead to his/her disqualification.
2. At the completion of the internship, each participant may need to give an oral and/or a written report on his/her works.

FAQ

Q: Can I apply more than both the STAR and HK Space Museum internship?

A: Yes, you may apply for more than one programme, you need to state your preference in the application forms and you can accept only one offer.

Q: Can a participant still do a final-year project?

A: This is up to your potential final-year project supervisor. It is your responsibility to tell your potential supervisor that you plan to take up this internship. You may have to make a choice between this program and a final-year project.

Q: Can a participant still join summer research internship or other activities?

A: Due to the time clash, it is not possible to join both the STAR internship, and the summer research internship. It may however be possible for other activities. Please contact Dr. Leung for further details and discussions.

Q: What is the training program about?

A: Participants may be asked to read relevant material, so that they can acquire basic knowledge before working in the institutes. For STAR participants, you are required to prepare course materials.
