The technical amendments to the *Regulations Governing Undergraduate Medicine Programme* for students admitted to the six-year curriculum with effect from 2017-18 were noted.

The recommendation of the Board of the Faculty of Medicine to amend the *Regulations for the Degree* of *Doctor of Medicine* with effect from 2017-18 was approved.
