

MyCUHK is your one-stop portal for personalized access to various online resources from The Chinese University of Hong Kong. It is also the primary entrance for all the services provided by CUSIS, the Chinese University Student Information System.

MyCUHK allows single sign-on - the ability to login with a single account and access multiple applications. You can use your email alias (i.e. [xxx@cuhk.edu.hk](mailto:xxx@cuhk.edu.hk)) as Login ID and CWEM password to login MyCUHK.

MyCUHK also allows user-customization. In addition to providing commonly used applications such as emails, announcements, helpdesk, users are able to define a unique and personal view of MyCUHK by choosing and adding services they are interested.

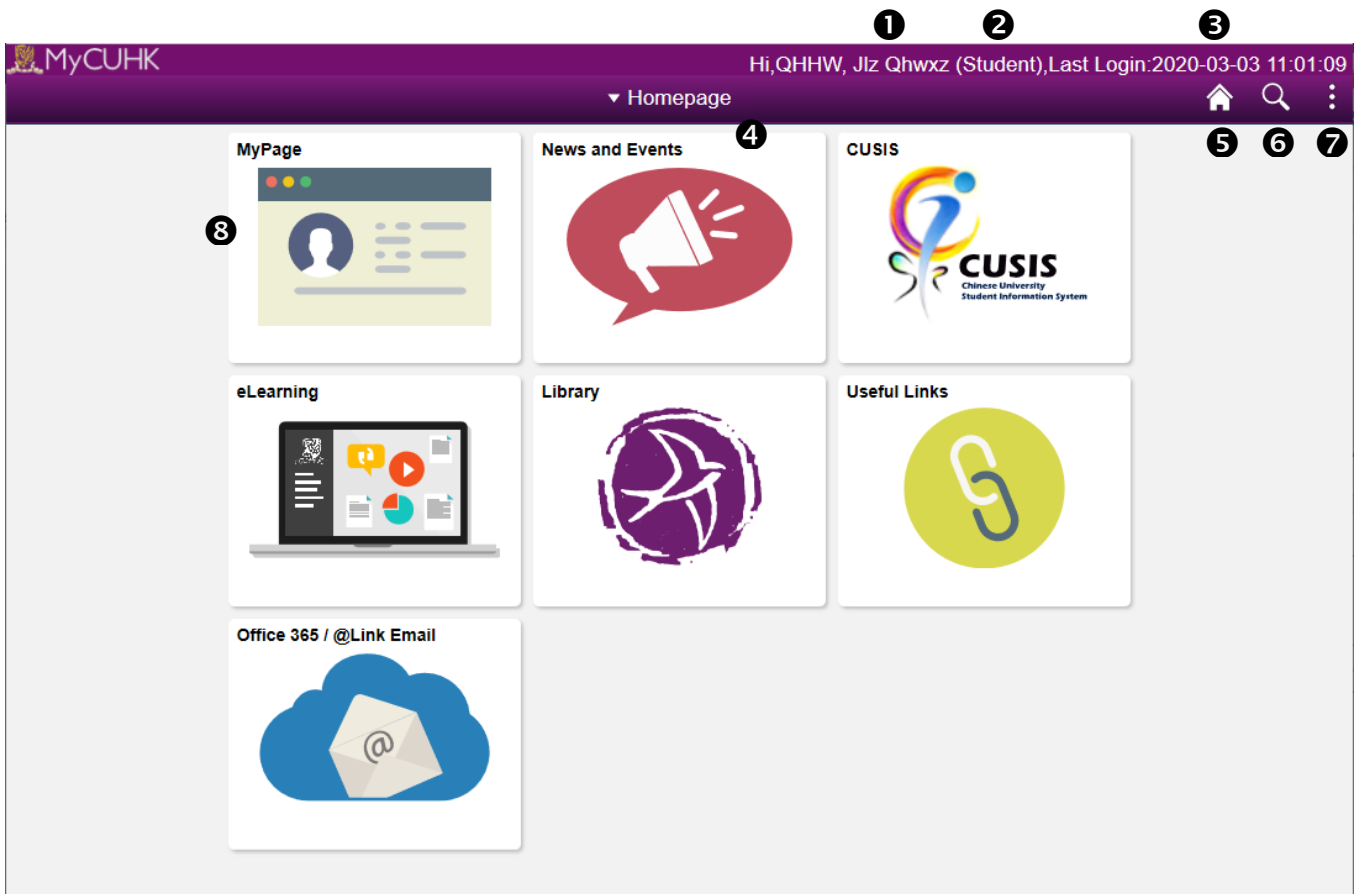

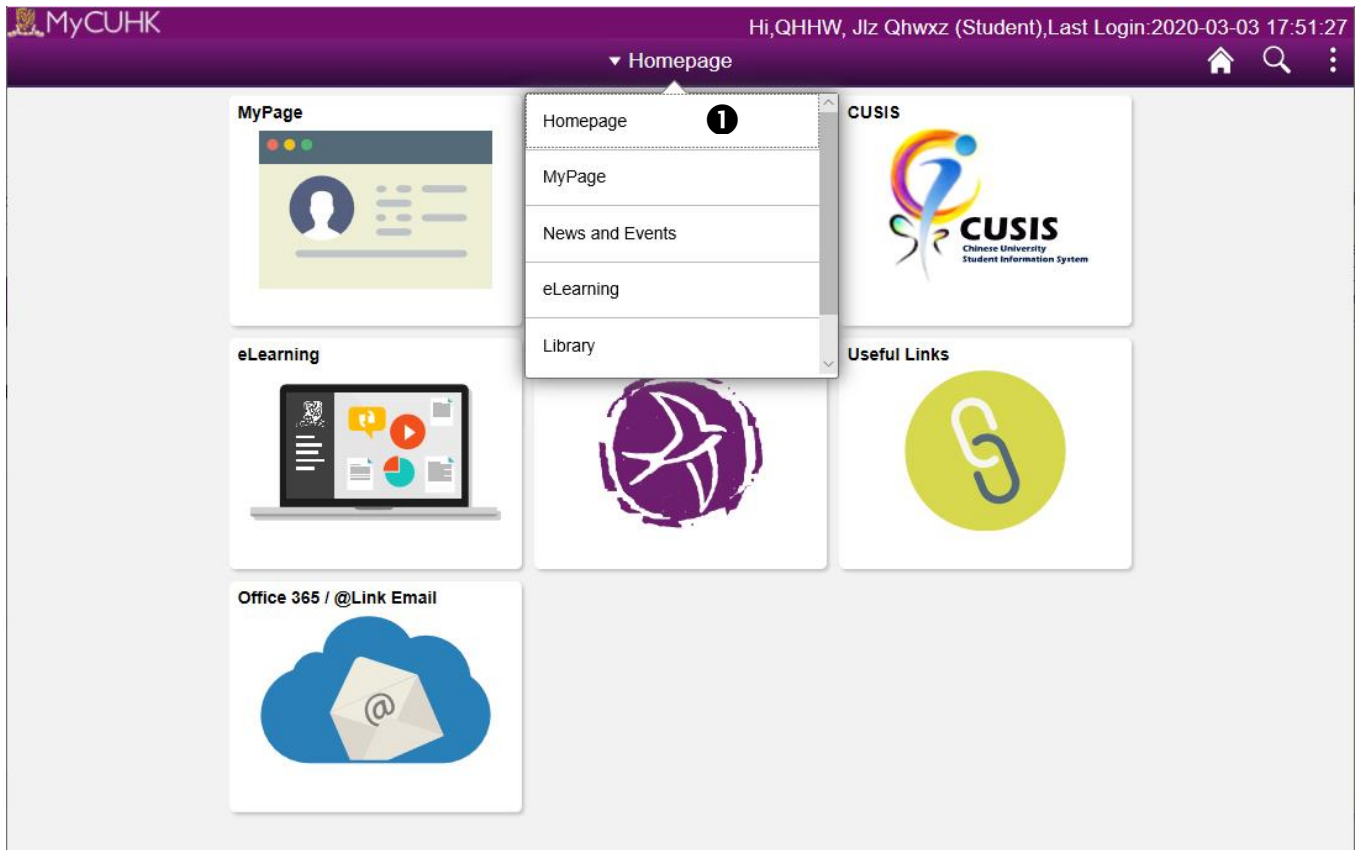
1. Input your email alias (i.e. xxx@cuhk.edu.hk) as Login ID

## 2. BASIC PORTAL LAYOUT – HOMEPAGE



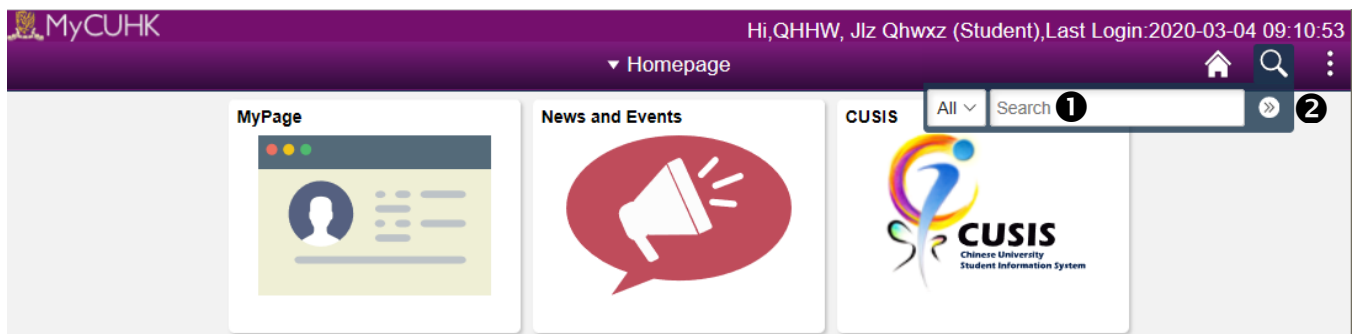
1. Your full name

### 3. BASIC PORTAL LAYOUT – HOMEPAGE DROPPDOWN LIST

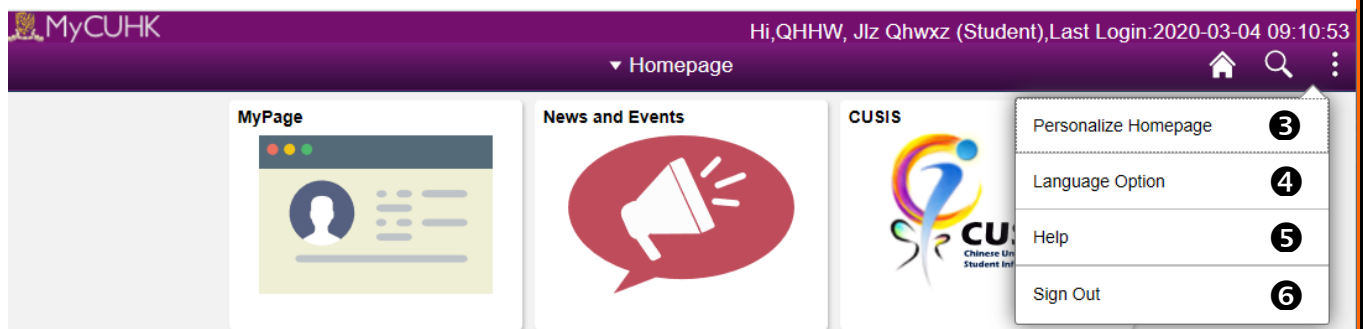


1. Homepage Dropdown List shows all the pages available for users to access. Users can choose to switch to different page by clicking the dropdown list.

#### 4. BASIC PORTAL LAYOUT – SEARCH FUNCTION & ACTION LIST

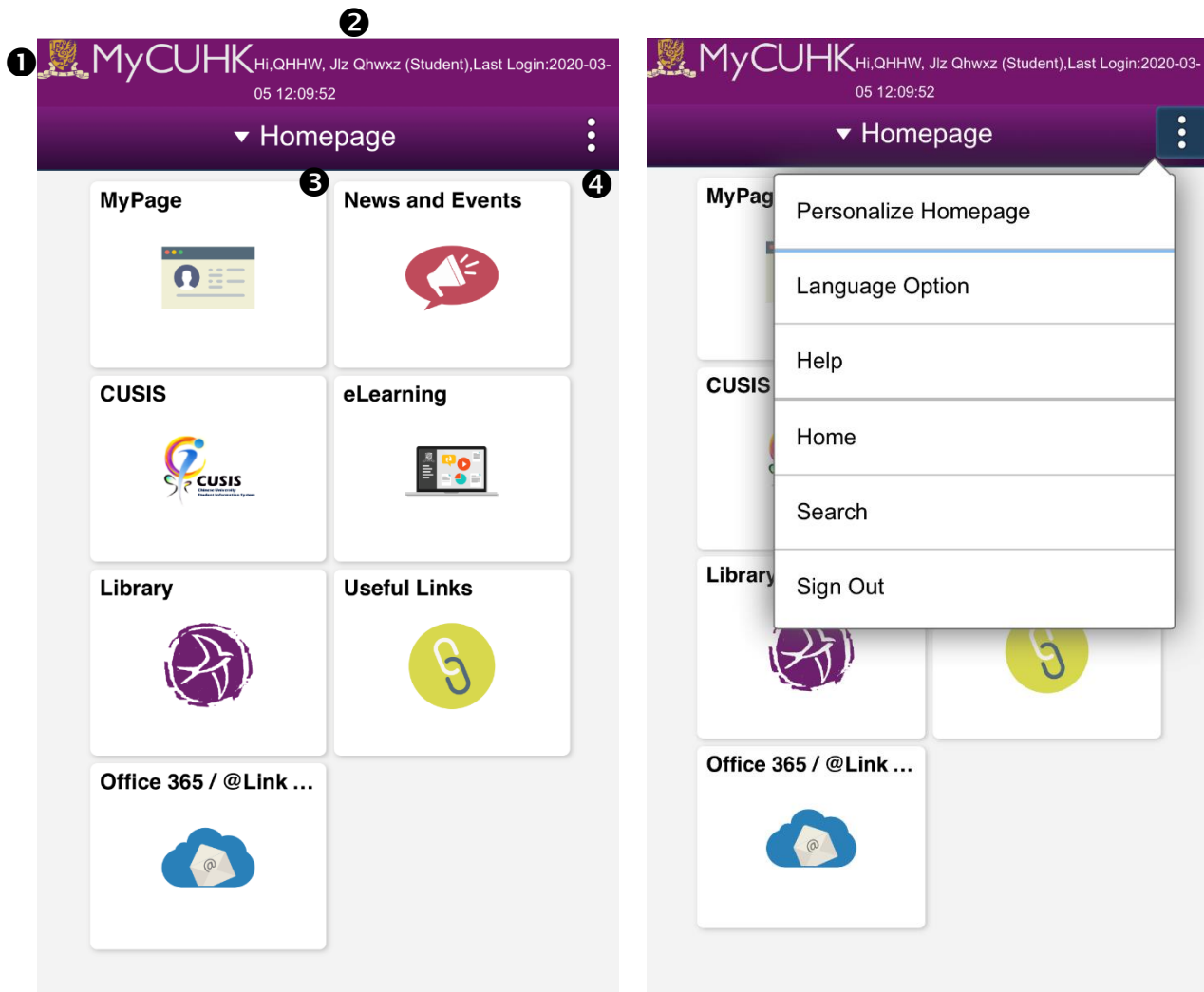


1. You can type in a keyword there

4. Can change language to English or Traditional Chinese

## 5. BASIC PORTAL LAYOUT (MOBILE VIEW)



In mobile version, the header will shrink its information to only display the following information:

1. MyCUHK logo
2. Welcome message and login information
3. Dropdown list to switch to different Fluid Pages
4. Action Menu to direct to different links

Despite missing icons for Home button and navigation bar, these functions will be placed inside the Action Menu. Hence, the Action Menu in the mobile version contains more information than that of computer version.

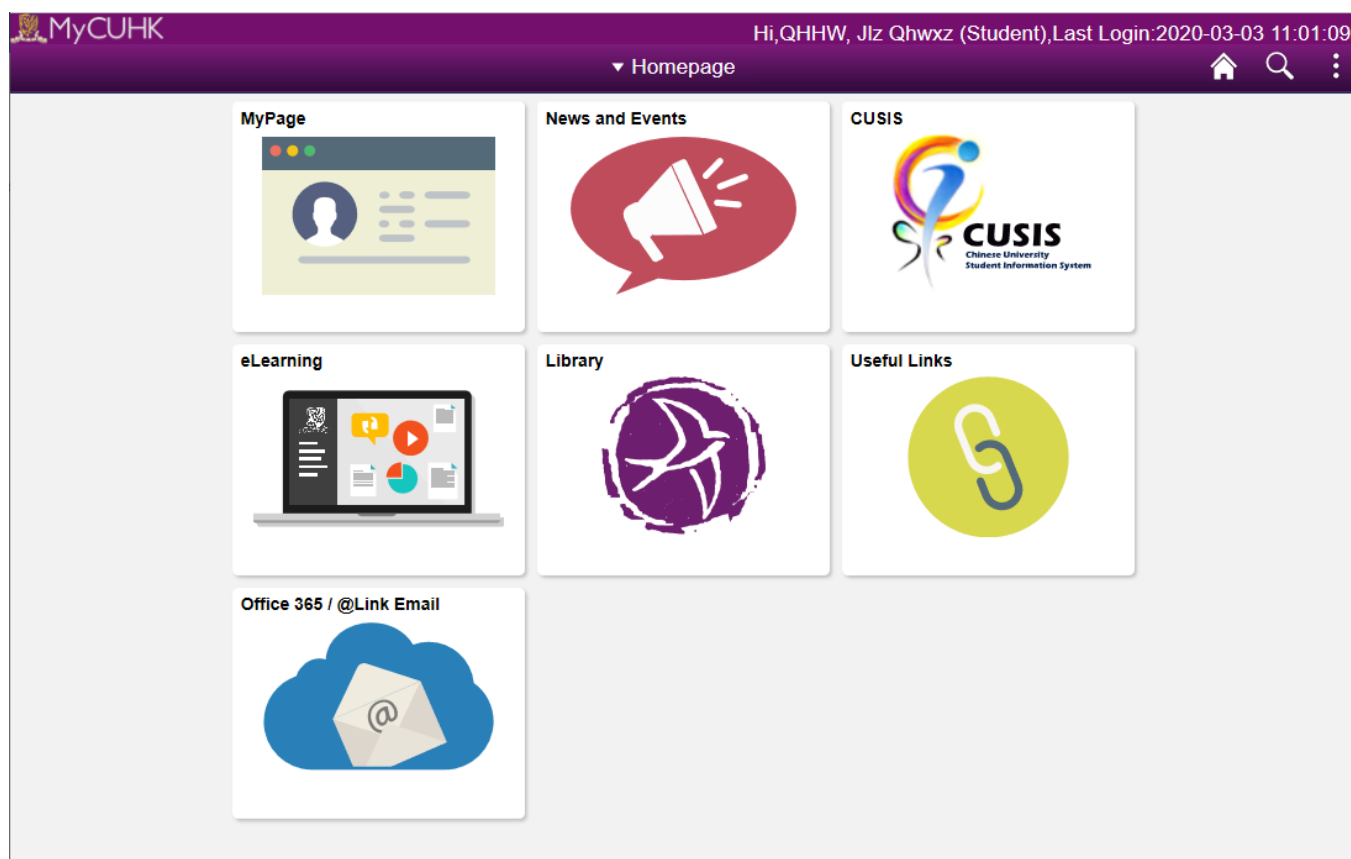
## 6. PERSONALIZED VIEW OF THE PORTAL

Students will be presented with the following seven tiles, namely,

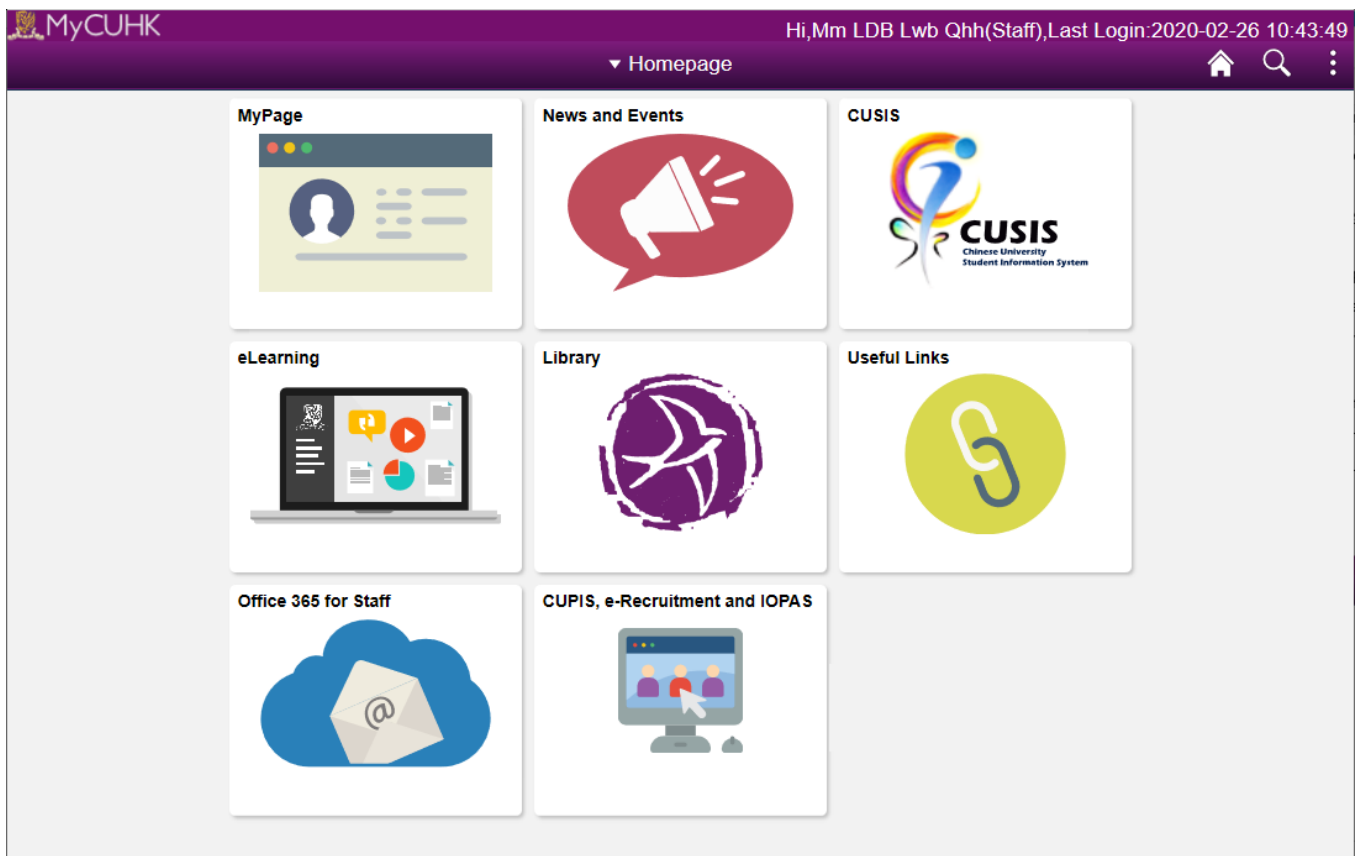
- My Page – a customizable page for students

## The Student view of the portal

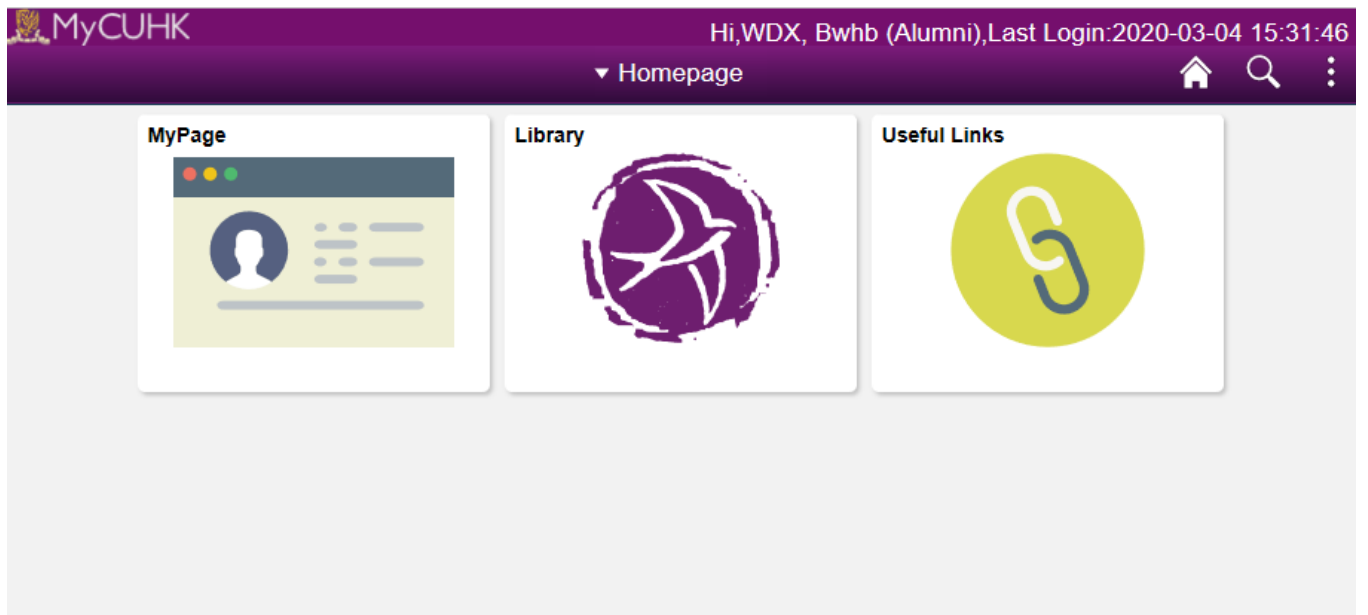
Student will be presented with the following eight tiles, namely,

Alumni will be presented with the following three tiles, namely,

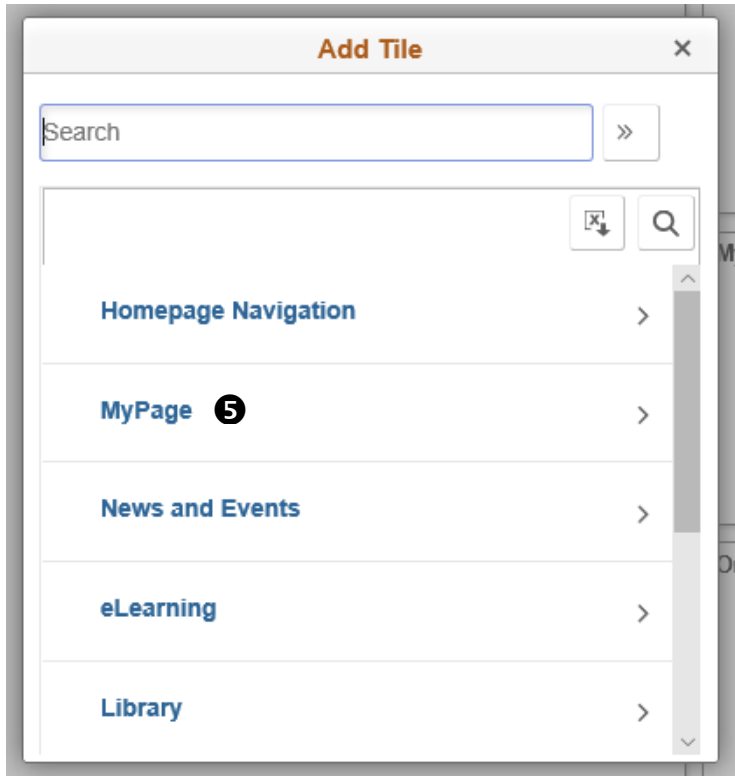

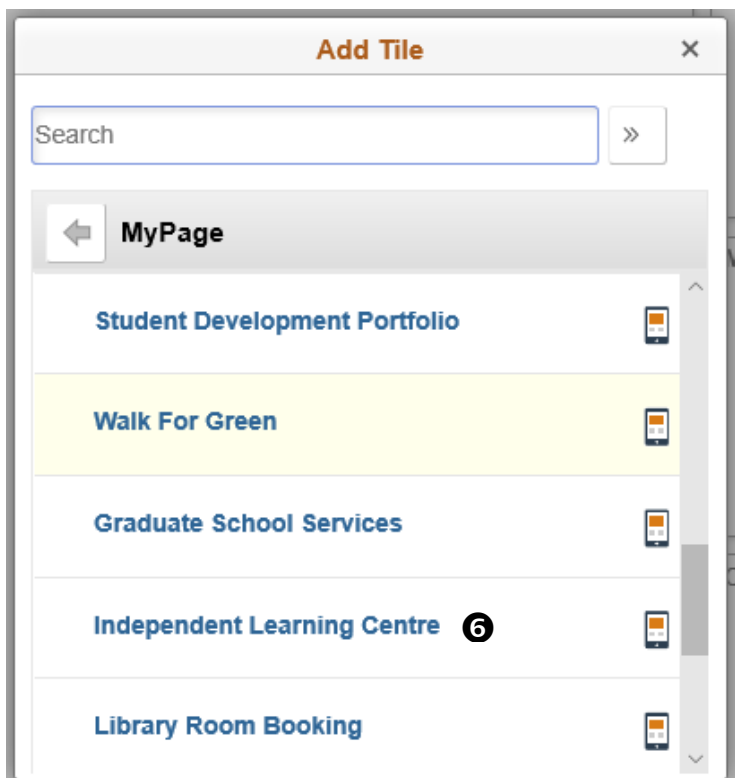

4. Save the homepage after making any changes

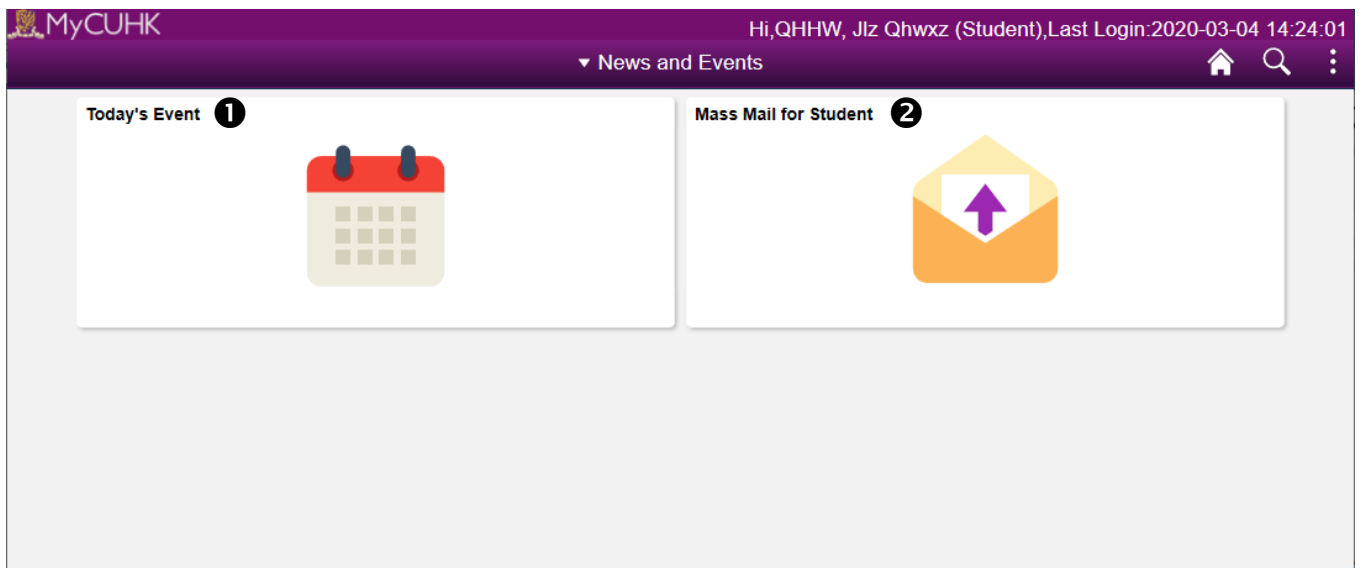


5. After clicking the 'Add Tile' button, you can select a tile from any homepage. In this example, we choose 'MyPage' homepage.



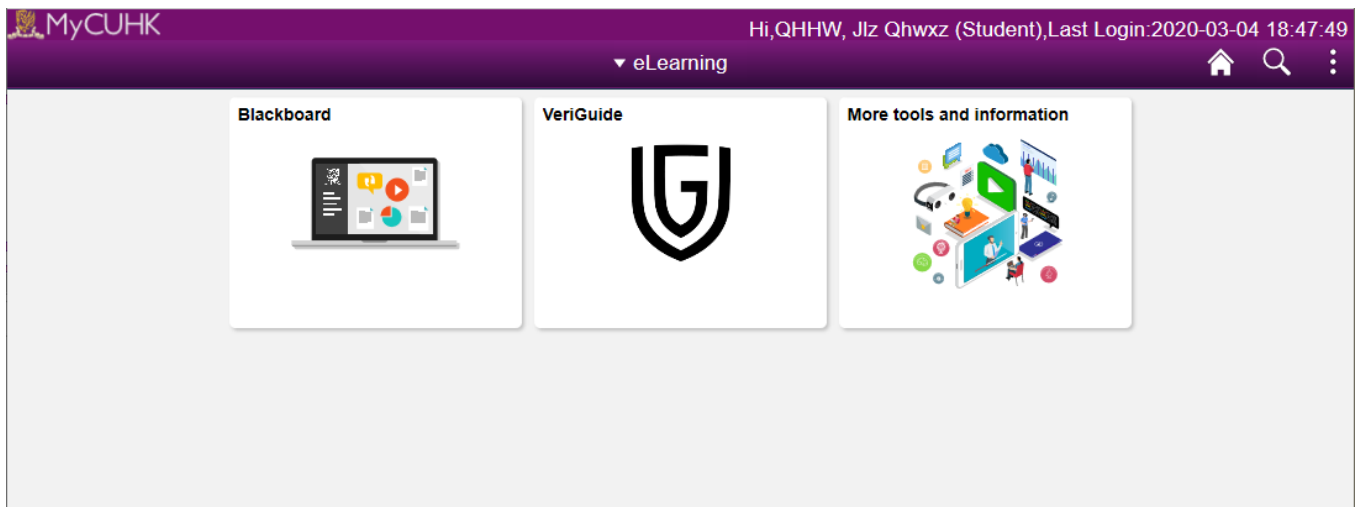

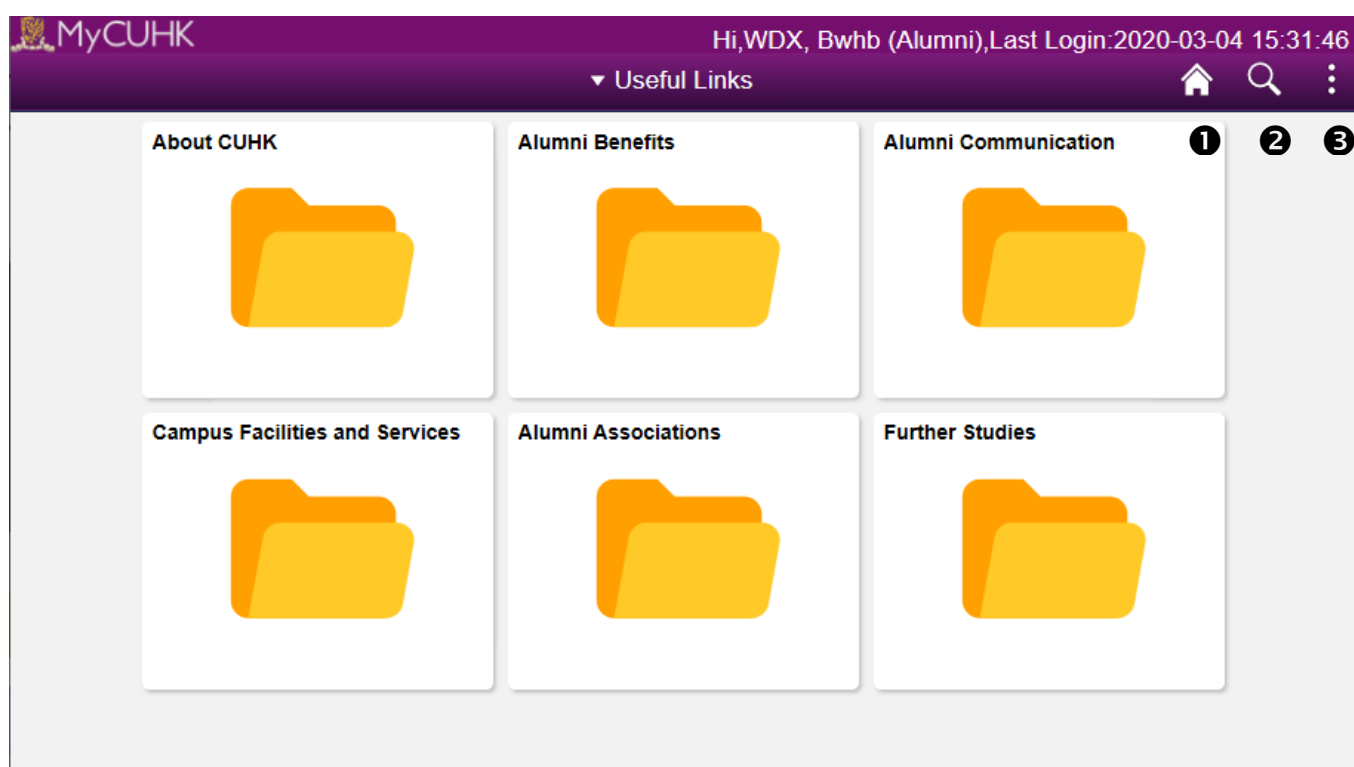
