**Summary of Feedback from Stage 2 Engagement Meeting on Campus Master Plan**

**No. of Participants: 26**

**Key Planning Issues**

**1. Enhancement of College Life**

- Consider to provide gymnasium in Shaw College or United College other than the proposed sports hub in Sir Philip Haddon Cave Sports Field.

Chung Chi College

- Avoid constructing covered walkway in Chung Chi College.
- Concern about the proposed new pedestrian routes that may bring more people passing through the College.

**2. Venues for Academic & Recreational Activities**

- Avoid over-crowding the Mall and Chung Chi College.
- Provide more communal spaces for the interaction between teaching staffs and students.
- Provide amenity facilities in Area 39.

**3. Creating a Pedestrian-Friendly Campus**

- Consider to separate vehicles and pedestrians.
- Review shuttle bus stop locations.
- Consider establishment of vehicular free zone.
- Encourage university members to walk.
- Provide more vertical transports along the main pedestrian route.
- Concern about the bottleneck effect in the vertical transport area.
- Consider to use underground tunnels to connect the whole campus.
- Provide a good pedestrian connection network for the staff, students and visitors in Area 39.
- Provide mini shuttle bus running from Shaw College to Area 39 in order to minimize the size of the roundabout in Shaw College.
- Provide more small and shaded walkways.
- Provide covered walkways for key routes.
- Provide stairs with wider steps and add more landings.
- Use more natural materials in the construction.
- Classify different pedestrian routes in the campus.
- Support centralized car parking at the fringe of the campus that helps reducing car movement in the campus.
- Reduce the conflicts between pedestrians and vehicles.
- Suggest acquiring hybrid buses to replace existing buses for reducing pollution.
- Provide sufficient disabled access in the campus.

**4. Campus Landscape**

- Provide more lawns for social gatherings.
- Provide gathering spaces with shading.

**Other Issues**

- Consider population growth when formulating various strategies in the CMP.
