**Summary of Feedback from Stage 2 Engagement Meeting on Campus Master Plan**

**Date: 3 October 2008**

**Time: 7:00pm – 9:15pm**

**No. of Participants: 12**

**Key Planning Issues**

**1. Enhancement of College Life**

- Enhance identity to each college other than providing courtyards.
- Avoid over-loading the resources and facilities of the existing colleges, such as library, by the new colleges.
- Enhance students' sense of belongings to their colleges.
- Encourage students to use the open gathering spaces.
- Provide more amenity and recreational facilities in Shaw College and new colleges.
- Recommend further discussions with college representatives before formulating the Specific Plan.
- Provide recreational facilities in the new colleges.

Shaw College

- Provide amenity facilities, such as library.

New Colleges

- Consider possibilities for future expansion of the colleges and reserve spaces around them.
- Provide more amenity facilities in new colleges.

**2. Venues for Academic & Recreational Activities**

- Consider to provide some large indoor spaces for social gatherings other than the open courtyards.
- Avoid over-crowding the Mall and Chung Chi College.
- Support the proposed faculty clusters as it will achieve physical proximity and obtain the benefit of interdisciplinary collaboration.
- Consider to provide more teaching facilities in New Asia College and United College to ease the congestion in Central Campus.

**3. Creating a Pedestrian-Friendly Campus**

- Provide a comprehensive planning regarding the connectivity between Area 39 and various parts of the campus.
- Explore possibilities with MTRC to provide a new MTR station between University Station and Tai Po Market Station.
- Review shuttle bus services due to future population growth.

**4. Campus Landscape**

- Review the role of the Mall as many University members treat it as a passage rather than an open space for gathering.

**5. Conservation of Places with Cultural Significance**

- Concern about the establishment of 'List of Places with Cultural Significant'. Expect for more transparency in the establishment process.

**Other Issues**

- Concern about the tight schedule for the consultation.
- Promote teaching and learning atmosphere.
