3. Students who study for one school term is not entitled to any award-bearing certificate.							
4. Students studying the advanced level should refer to a separate sheet of study scheme to learn about the optimal combination of courses for your study.							
5. Students in planning their study should observe the maximum study period of programmes, namely 2 years (Foundation Certificate Programmes), 2 years (Certificate Programmes), 3 years (Diploma programmes) and 5 years (Advanced Diploma Programmes) respectively. Some courses may not be available in every school term and students should check whether it will cause impact to their student visa sponsorship.							
6. Student visa sponsorship is available to students who take full course (15 credits/ 5 courses) each at level 1 to 3 and a minimum of 12 credits (4 courses) in each of the school term in their advance studies. No student visa sponsorship will be given to part-time students.							
7. Continuing Education Fund (CEF) applicants are reminded that some reimbursable courses are not always available due to minimum enrolment. There may be a chance that reimbursement will not be approved by CEF in such a case. A student is advised to have a flexible schedule and study scheme in line with the CEF requirement to increase the chance in getting course reimbursement.
