- Abundant after-school activities



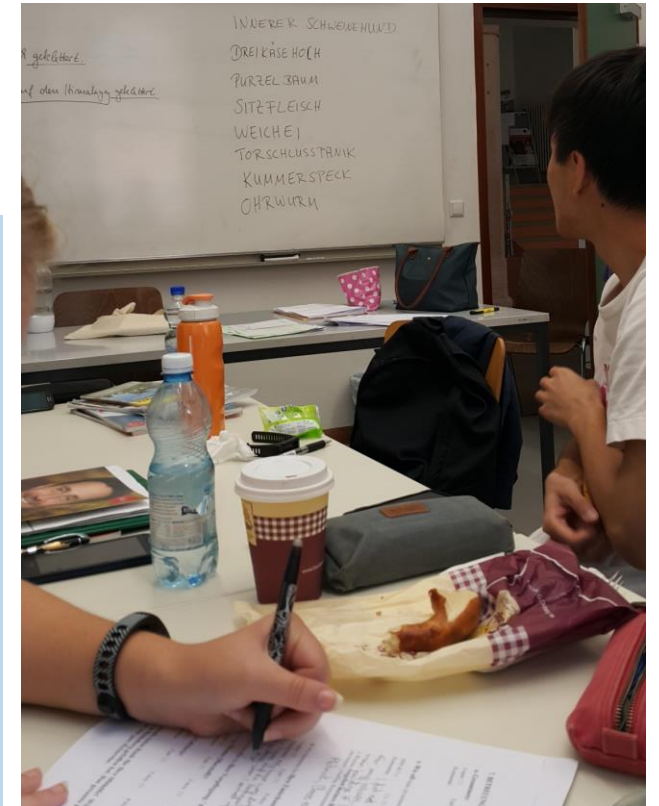
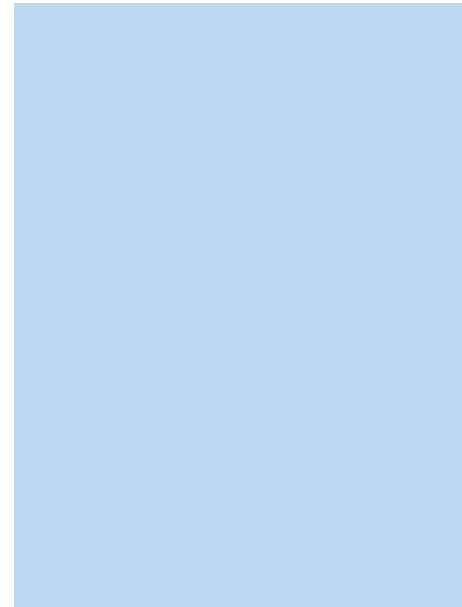
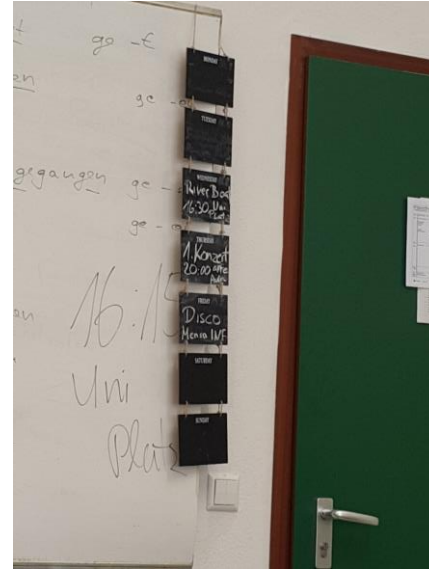
Courses

 - ~15 student

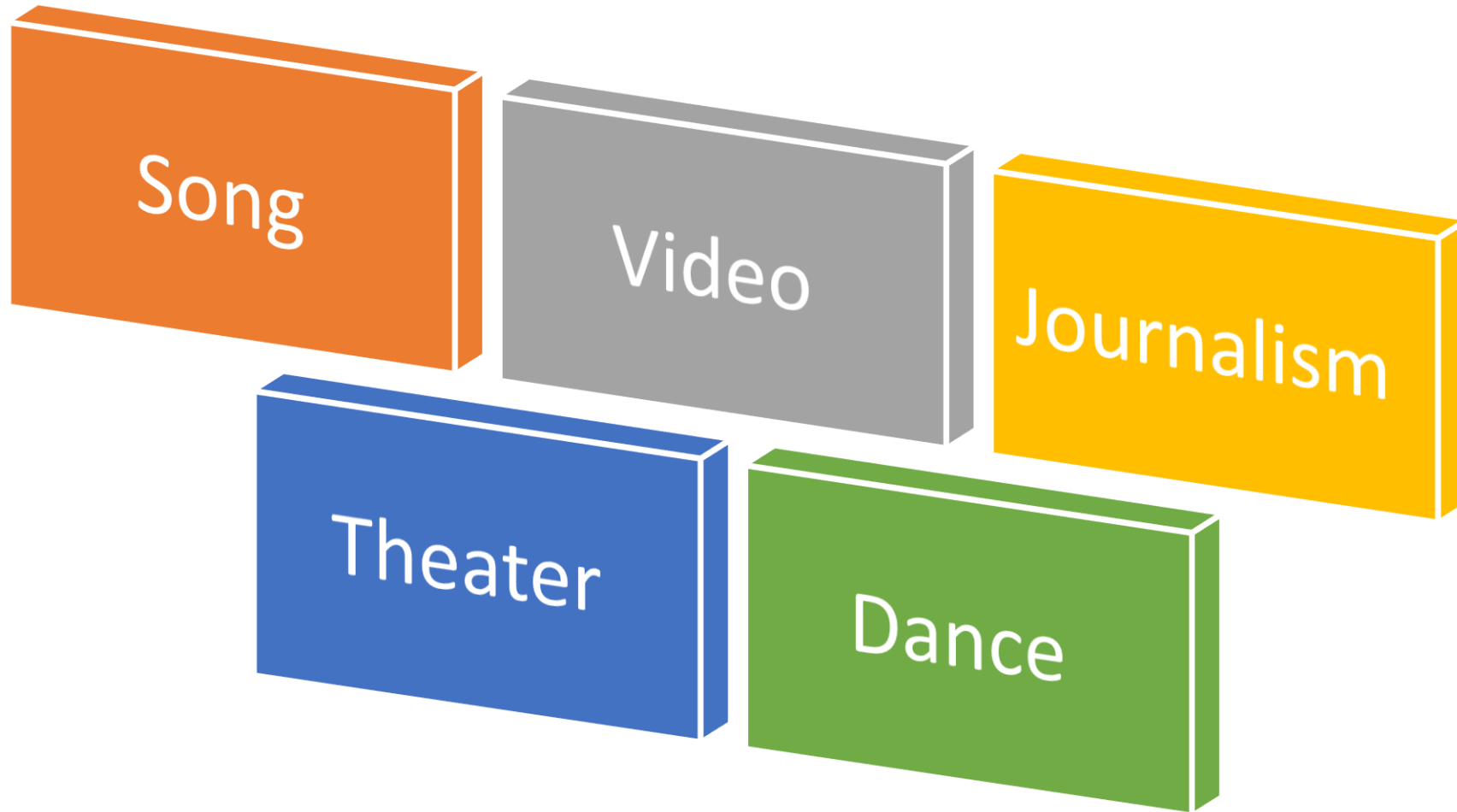


Teaching Style

Meals

- Cook by yourself

Tips:

- Buy ingredients **BEFORE** Sunday

- Eat at Mensa
 - 0.8€/ 100g
 - 'hang out' place at lunch
 - Buffet style
 - 3 Mensas:
 - Uni-platz
 - Neueheimerfeld
 - Marchstallstr.
- Tips:
- Beware of the notice in Mensa
 - e.g. Breakfast morning in one Saturday every month
 - Plastic bottle can be recycled in Mensa and refund 0.25€ to your Campus card



Meals

- Eat out
- Many places for us to eat
 - Restaurants:
 - Expensive
 - Trinkgeld
 - Food court / fast food / self-served restaurants
 - Street food

Notes:

- Bars and pubs have different discounts for students everyday
- Asian food: eat and also buy ingredients



Accommodation

- Randomly selected by school
 - **Shared flat (Neueheimerfeld / Altstadt)**
 - Host family
 - Room in family home
 - 360€
- Hostel (Jugendherberger)
- Find other places to stay online




Accommodation

- Bring your own bed sheets
- No air-conditioner
 - BUT weather is cool (~15-16 Grad.), sometimes even cold at night
- Not necessarily have WiFi, washing machine, lift
- May share some chores
- **Recycling rubbish**
 - According to particular bins (bio wastes, plastic, paper, glass, metal, clothes etc.)
- Aware of notices from Studentwerk

- **Participants must be 18 years or older.**
- Download the **form “Registration”** online
- Fill in your information and return it by e-mail to ferienkurs@zuv.uni-heidelberg.de.
- If you are accepted, you will have three weeks to
 - pay the **course fee (€ 670,-)** by bank transfer
 - copy of your **passport** or other ID,
 - copy of the **bank transfer receipt**
 - form **“Accommodation Reservation”**
