- Jointly organised by Morningside College and School of Continuing and Professional Studies (CUSCS) of CUHK
- Provides professional career facilitation service by career development facilitators
- Guides alumni to enhance self-understanding for planning or embarking on their career development through face-to-face consultations and assessments
- Matching of one alumna/us with one career development facilitator by CUSCS



The School of Continuing and Professional Studies of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUSCS) launched the Global Career Development Facilitator (GCDF) Programme in 2014 and the Facilitating Career Development (FCD) Programme in 2019. Among the more than 1,200 trainees who have completed the programmes are experienced professionals from various fields including education, administration and management, human resources and training, social work and helping professions.

There are 2 types of certified career development facilitators – Certified Career Services Provider (CCSP) and Global Career Development Facilitator (GCDF). The CCSP credential is certified by the National Career Development Association (NCDA), while the GCDF credential is certified by the Center for Credentialing and Education (CCE) of the National Board for Certified Counsellors (NBCC), U.S.A.
