A talk on “Gender Equality in Workplace” was held on 6 January 2010 in LT2, Teaching Complex at Western Campus. Ms. Wong Nga-fong, Raven, Assistant Supervisor of CEASE Crisis Centre of the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals, was invited to be guest speaker. Around 50 staff members from various units attended the talk.

Ms. Wong discussed gender equality and related issues with the participants in an interactive way. Through daily life examples, the participants had a better understanding of the issues. They found the talk helpful in heightening their awareness of how to achieve gender equality in the workplace.

## **In-house Luncheon Seminar on “Major Concerns in Handling Sexual Harassment Cases”**

An In-house Luncheon Seminar on “Major Concerns in Handling Sexual Harassment Cases” was held on Monday, 14 December 2009 in the University’s Guest House Restaurant. The objective of the seminar was to provide our members with updating knowledge and practical experience in dealing with sexual harassment cases. Ms. Lam Siu-wai, Chief Equal Opportunities Officer of Equal Opportunities Commission, and Ms. Wong Nga-fong, Raven, Assistant Supervisor of the CEASE Crisis Centre of the Tung Wah Group of Hospitals, were invited to be the guest speakers.

Ms. Lam of the EOC shared with our members key issues in investigating sexual harassment complaints. She highlighted that the increasing cases of online sexual harassment will be the new challenge for the combat against sexual harassment. Ms. Wong of the CEASE Crisis Centre introduced the services provided by the Centre and shared with the participants her hands-on experience in handling sexual harassment cases.
